Registration Ordered for Prospective Immigrants

Washington—(NC)—The State Department announced that applications will be accepted immediately from Germans, Austrians and all war refugees in the Western occupation zones of Europe. In a restoration of the German and Austrian quotas which though not suspended seven years ago were not available to Germans and Austrians within their respective countries.

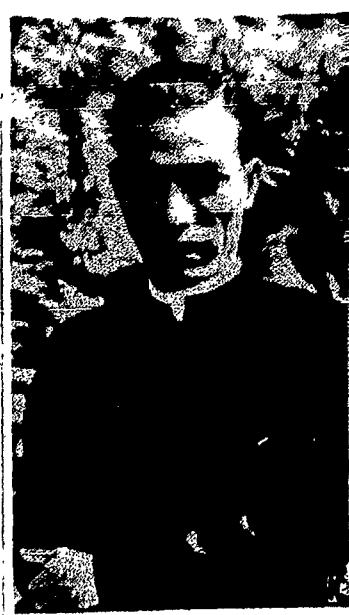
The purpose of the registration is to establish priority for places in the quotas—set at 25,000 for Germany and 1,413 for Austria. It was made clear that the quotas are separate from those established for the entrance of displaced persons into the United States and that visas will be served under regular immigration procedure.

Although there is no relationship between the immigrant and DP quotas—the latter will admit 205,000 persons in the next two years—the State Department said all DPs will be urged to register anyway so that they will have a chance at immigrating under quotas if they are found ineligible for DP admission.

Movement of DPs, first of whom are expected to start for this country in October, will precede by some time the admission of the first immigrants under the ordinary quotas.

Registration will be accomplished at consular offices in Berlin, Bremen, Frankfurt, Hamburg, Munich, Stuttgart, Germany, and in Vienna and Salzburg, Austria.

Vienna—(NC)—The 1,200th anniversary of the establishment of the Benedictine Order in Upper Austria was solemnly marked at ceremonies which were attended by Dr. Karl Frenner, President of the Republic of Austria, the Minister of Education, and representatives of Church and civil authorities.

The celebration took place at Mondsee in the Salzkammergut.

The first translation of the Bible into German—one of the most important documents for German linguistic research—goes back to the year of the foundation of the monastery. It was there, too, that one of the world's masterpieces in wood-carving, the so-called Michael Pacher altar, of St. Wolfgang, had its origin.

In 1791, the old monastery was dissolved, sharing the fate of so many other centuries-old monastic institutions that became victims of the era of "enlightenment."

Lourdes Welcomes Irish Doctors

Dublin—(NC)—An invitation has been extended to Irish doctors and specialists to associate themselves with the Medical Bureau of Lourdes by Dr. Francois Lourde, bureau president.

In an open letter made public here, the Lourdes official describes his bureau as fitted with "modern medical, scientific equipment which enables us to undertake clinical, radiological and biological examinations of the sick on their arrival at Lourdes." "If there is a cure these investigations provide indisputable proof."

"If you come to Lourdes to work you will not lose your time," the letter states. "Lourdes is a veritable pathological museum. Every year there pass through the hospitals of Lourdes about 10,000 sick. Among them are found the most extraordinary, the rarest and most instructive cases. Doctors who come to Lourdes profit by their visits by perfecting themselves both intellectually and scientifically."

Pilgrimage Prays For Russia, Peace

Dubuque, Ia.—(NC)—Archbishop Francis J. Beckman, retired, who is conducting the first national pilgrimage from the United States in the Shrine of Our Lady of Fatima, Portugal, believes Communism is the greatest enemy the world has today and will lead the pilgrims, pray for Russia and world peace.

The only panacea for the ills of the world today is prayer, the archbishop said. He recalled that when Our Lady appeared in six apparitions to three Portuguese children between May 13 and October 13, 1917, she told them that penance, prayer, consecration of the world to her Immaculate Heart, and conversion of sinners would lead to the conversion of Russia and peace.

The pilgrimage is scheduled to arrive in Portugal October 9.

Monsignor Rossi served during the war with the Apostolic Nunciature in Berlin. He succeeds Msgr. Alberto Giovannetti, who was given a new assignment at the Papal Secretariate of State.

A new assistant has also been appointed to Bishop Muench in his capacity as military vicar delegate for the American armed forces in Germany and Austria. In the person of the Rev. Thomas F. Corcoran of Lowell, Mass., who lately has served as deputy chaplain of the 5th Army at San Francisco. He formerly had been secretary to the Bishop of Alexandria, La.

The appointment was made by His Eminence Francis Cardinal Spellman, Vicar for the armed forces of the United States. Father Corcoran will also serve as deputy chief chaplain of the European Command at Heidelberg.

U. S. Carmelite Nuns Plan China Convent

Shanghai—(RNS)—First foundation of Carmelite nuns from the United States will be established in Yangchow before the end of the year, according to an announcement by the Very Rev. Paul W. O'Brien, superior of the Catholic Mission at Yangchow, in north Kiangsu.

He said six Carmelites from the order's convent in Santa Clara, Calif., would sail from San Francisco late in October to found the new convent at Yangchow. There is a Carmelite convent at Zikawei, but that was founded by French sisters in 1869.

Austria Honors Chaplain Erie, Pa.—(NC)—Lauded as "a sincere friend and tireless patron of Catholic youth," the Rev. Bernard K. McDonald, Army chaplain and a member of the Missionary Servants of the Most Holy Trinity, has been awarded the unusual title of honorary Episcopal Coadjutor of the Consistory of the Diocese of Linz, Austria.
