### Former Belgian Communist Started Catholic Lay Group

Dublin — (BNS) — A former Communist and one-time editor of Drapeau Rouge (Red Flag), official newspaper of the Communist Party in Belgium, was responsible for organizing the Legion of Mary, international Catholic lay organization, in the Malines diocese.

This was disclosed here by the Most Rev. Leo J. Suenens, Auxiliary Bishop of Malines, at a meeting of the Legion's Concilium, or supreme governing council.

The Legion was founded in Dublin 27 years ago.

Bishop Suenens said the Communist editor was converted to Catholicism after making a pilgrimage to a shrine at Beauring, and afterwards wrote to Cardinal van Roey, Archbishop of Malines, asking permission to start the Legion of Mary in Belgium, where the organization was then virtually unknown.

The Bishop added that the Legion now exists in five of the six dioceses of Belgium, namely, Malines, Tournai, Liege, Namur, and Ghent.
