

German Radio Shows Get Priest-Director

Frankfurt—(NC)—Mgr. Bernard Marschall of Gruiten near Duesseldorf, Rhineland, has been confirmed as chairman of the Catholic broadcasting office established by the German Hierarchy. Monsignor Marschall, one of the most distinguished experts in the field of European broadcasting and a pioneer from the early days of Catholic radio, will maintain close contacts with the liaison officials now functioning in all German dioceses.

Japan Catholics Get Radio Plant

Tokyo—(RNS)—Formation of the Japan Catholic Broadcasting Corporation to sponsor nationwide religious programs has been announced here. The corporation will be under the joint control of missionary priests and Japanese Catholic laymen. Preparations for the Catholic broadcasts are being pushed, pending passage of a bill before the Japanese Diet to make network facilities available for such programs. Purpose of the broadcasts, it was announced, will be to promote "moral uplift, sound democratic ideas, and the clean family life needed for the country's reconstruction, and which only the Christian religion can give."

Crosby Donates Pipe to Auction

London—(NC)—Bing Crosby has sent a pipe to be auctioned off at Assumption Convent, Charlton, London, for funds to help the Augustinians of the Assumption maintain their seminary in Britain. The Very Rev. Msgr. Andrew Beck, A.A., Coadjutor Bishop of Brentwood, will attend. Mr. Crosby sent the pipe at the request of a London girl, Miss F. Shepherd, of Bethnal Green.

Priest-Doctor Leaves China After Handling 60,000 Cases

Shanghai—(NC)—With a record of 60,000 consultations in 5 years at a rural North China hospital, a 42-year-old medical missionary, the Rev. Marcel Lichtenberger, S.J., has left here by plane for France. Father Lichtenberger is a physician, and was director of the Catholic hospital in the mission of Sienhsien, Hopei province. In that capacity, since 1942, the young Belgian priest gave 60,000 individual consultations and treatments. During the Sino-Japanese war, he often performed surgical operations and gave medical treatment to wounded soldiers at great risk to his own life. The priest operated 302 cases of cancer. "One of my most consoling experiences," he said, "was an operation that restored sight to a woman who had been blind for 20 years. After the operation, she saw for the first time the face of her 17-year-old son, recognizing him only by his voice when he began to speak."

Hollywood Minister Defends Stars' Morals

Tulsa, Okla.—(RNS)—Dr. Louis Hadley Evans, pastor of First Presbyterian Church, Hollywood, said here that the press is giving a one-sided picture in featuring stories of alleged loose morals among screen people. The Hollywood minister stressed that many motion picture people are regular churchgoers. He said they do not make the headlines for going to church and participating in church activities, because "nobody does." Many film notables are in his congregation every Sunday morning, he pointed out, and motion picture people often take part in church plays and use their talents to help the church. He said the "morbid appetite" of the press leads it to tell only the bad side of the Hollywood story.
