**Communist Aim in Religious
 Circles Told by House Group**

 United States assigns members to join churches and church organizations, in order to take control where possible, and in any case to influence thought and action toward Communist ends.

"IT FORMS front organizations designed to attract fellow travelers with religious interests. It tries to get prominent religious leaders to support Communist policies, designed as welfare work for minorities or oppressed groups."

Then followed these questions and answers:
 Q: Is your committee investigating religion?
 A: Certainly not. Religion is not under any sort of investigation by the House Committee on Un-American Activities, nor is any sect, creed, church or individual, so far as his religion is concerned.
 Q: Is the YMCA a Communist target?
 A: Yes, so is the YWCA. Also, church groups such as the Epworth League.
 Q: Do you mean every Epworth League or YWCA is a Communist hide-out?
 A: Of course not. But we do mean that Communists do dig into such groups any way and any time they can. We do mean they have dug into such groups and are at it today. We do mean that if you want to keep your own organization fit for your own family's membership, you had better stay alert.

The House committee also said the Protestant was "a magazine which fanatically spreads Communist propaganda under the guise of being a religious journal."

"Its avowed purpose," the booklet added, "is to 'build a bridge' between Christendom and Communism. Boasts support of 6,000 ministers but not actually connected with any official religious organization."

THE COMMITTEE asserted that the People's Institute of Applied Religion was "one of the most vicious Communist organizations ever set up in this country. Declared subversive by the Attorney General."

Describing the Rev. Claude C. Williams as director of the Institute, the committee report said "it teaches Communist ideas, pretending that they are Christian ideas."

The committee booklet, which took the form of 100 questions and answers, described the method of the Communist Party in its alleged attempt to corrupt religion in this country as follows:

 any belief in God is not in itself a very remarkable observation. Not at this late date, at least.

The remarkable thing is that at long last a Congressional Committee has openly recognized the atheistic character of Communism.

At long last somebody in the United States besides priests has admitted that Communism is a philosophy which spells the death warrant for all believers in God.

There is no longer any sensation in the discovery that Communists have vowed death to all religion. There is, however, some small sensation in the fact that American Congressmen have finally discovered what has been the commonplace knowledge of the Catholic Church for years and years.

THE CATHOLIC Church recognized the atheistic intent of Communism from the very beginning. She saw it when Karl Marx issued his "Das Kapital". She saw it in the Bolshevik Revolution in Russia. She saw it in pools of blood in Red Mexico and Red Spain. She saw the ominous flares of Red Atheism long before the Iron Curtain fell across the breast of Europe and statesmen like Mr. Churchill were screaming in angry protest.

Now the American Congressmen see what the Church saw first. Now they see what Pope Pius XI saw in 1937 when he issued his prophetic encyclical on Atheistic Communism.

TODAY OUR Congressmen tell us that "you cannot be a Communist and believe in God." But eleven years ago Pope Pius XI expressed it even more eloquently when he wrote: "For the first time in history we are witnessing a struggle, cold blooded in purpose and mapped out to the last detail, between men and 'all that is called God.' Communism is by its nature anti-religious."

And the same encyclical of Pius XI has that famous warning which so many to their sorrow ignored:

"Communism is intrinsically wrong, and no one who would save Christian civilization may collaborate with it in any undertaking whatsoever. Those who permit themselves to be decanted into lending their aid towards the triumph of Communism in their own country, will be the first to fall victims of their error."

Today many western statesmen have learned from bitter

experience the truth of this Papal warning uttered eleven years ago.

HIGHLIGHT OF the Un-American Activities Committee pamphlet is the revelation that American Communists have "dug into" even some religious groups and are still "at it."

In this regard the Committee's pamphlet singles out the Y.M.C.A., the Y.W.C.A., the Epworth League, and some Protestant ministers.

Once again the Congressmen are only confirming what Pius XI forecast eleven years ago in his encyclical. He wrote:

"Under various names which do not suggest Communism, they (Communists) establish organizations and periodicals with the sole purpose of carrying their ideas into quarters otherwise inaccessible. They try perfidiously to worm their way even into professedly Catholic and religious organizations. Again, without receding an inch from their subversive principles, they invite Catholics to collaborate with them in the realm of so-called humanitarianism and charity; and at times even make proposals that are in perfect harmony with the Christian spirit and doctrine of the Church."

THE PROPHECIC vision of Pius XI and the belated discovery of the Congressmen mean, at least, that once again the world has caught up with the Church.

All this is embarrassing to those foolish people who think a Papal Encyclical is only a dry unrealistic tract written by a pious and dream-eyed visionary living in the cloistered recesses of the Vatican. The Congressional discovery of Atheistic Communism disproves this stupid myth.

In a practical way the Congressional pamphlet proves what has been proven so many times in the past. The Catholic Church is right when the world is wrong. The Church sees even when the whole world is blind!

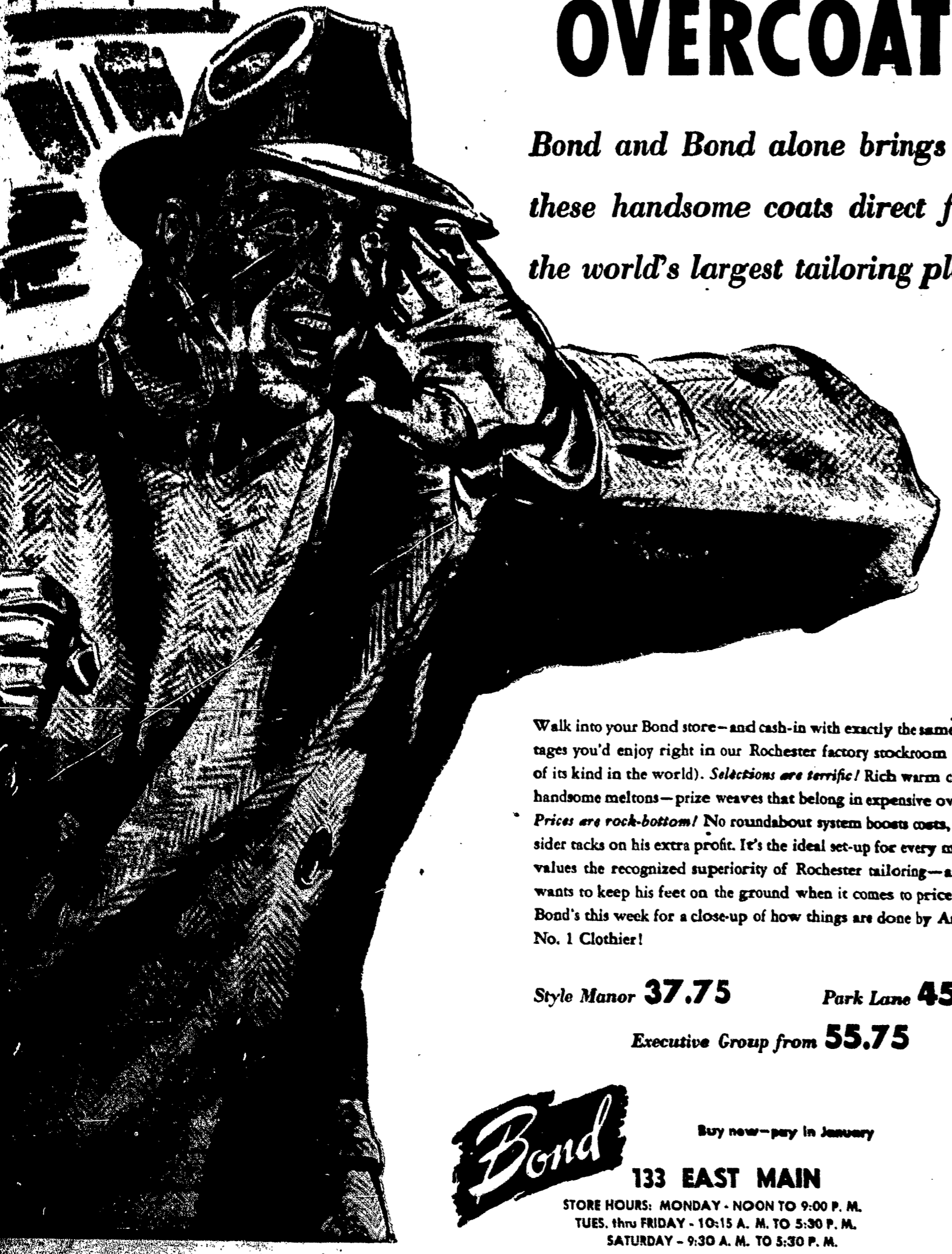
