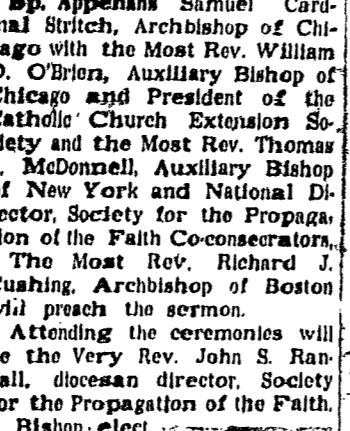

2 SVD Priests To Be Raised To Bishopric

Two of the Society of the Divine Word "native sons," both veteran missionaries, will be consecrated Bishops in the newly decorated Holy Ghost Chapel at St. Mary's Seminary, Techon, Ill., Tuesday, Nov. 30, according to the Very Rev. Raymond J. Welschberger, S.V.D., rector of St. Michael's Mission House at Cornucopia, N. Y.



To be elevated are the Most Rev. Stephen Appellans, S.V.D., Vicar Apostolic of East New Guinea and the Most Rev. Leo Arkfeld, S.V.D., Vicar Apostolic of Central New Guinea.

Bishop Appellans studied at St. Gabriel's Seminary, near Vienna, Austria, and was ordained in 1932. Since 1944, during the most difficult period of mission history in New Guinea, he reorganized and directed the mission work in the Vicariate entrusted to the Society of the Divine Word.

Bishop-elect Arkfeld of Iowa, was ordained in 1943. He was the first Catholic missionary to work in the rugged territory of Lae in Central New Guinea. He is ranked as one of the best flying missionaries in the Pacific. He will be the youngest Bishop in the Society of the Divine Word.

Cites Geneva Aid To Chapel In Germany Heidelberg, Germany—(NC)—Bishop Aloisius J. Muench, Apostolic Visitor to Germany, has praised American Army authorities for having made available "places where members of the Armed Forces can repair to put their hearts and souls into a relation of peace with their Maker."

The Bishop spoke at Benedictine services at St. Ann's Church here, and his remarks referred to its "fostering as a Catholic military chapel. Members of the American Catholic community here and of the parish of Geneva, N. Y., made voluntary contributions and the Army supported the project through the release of needed materials."

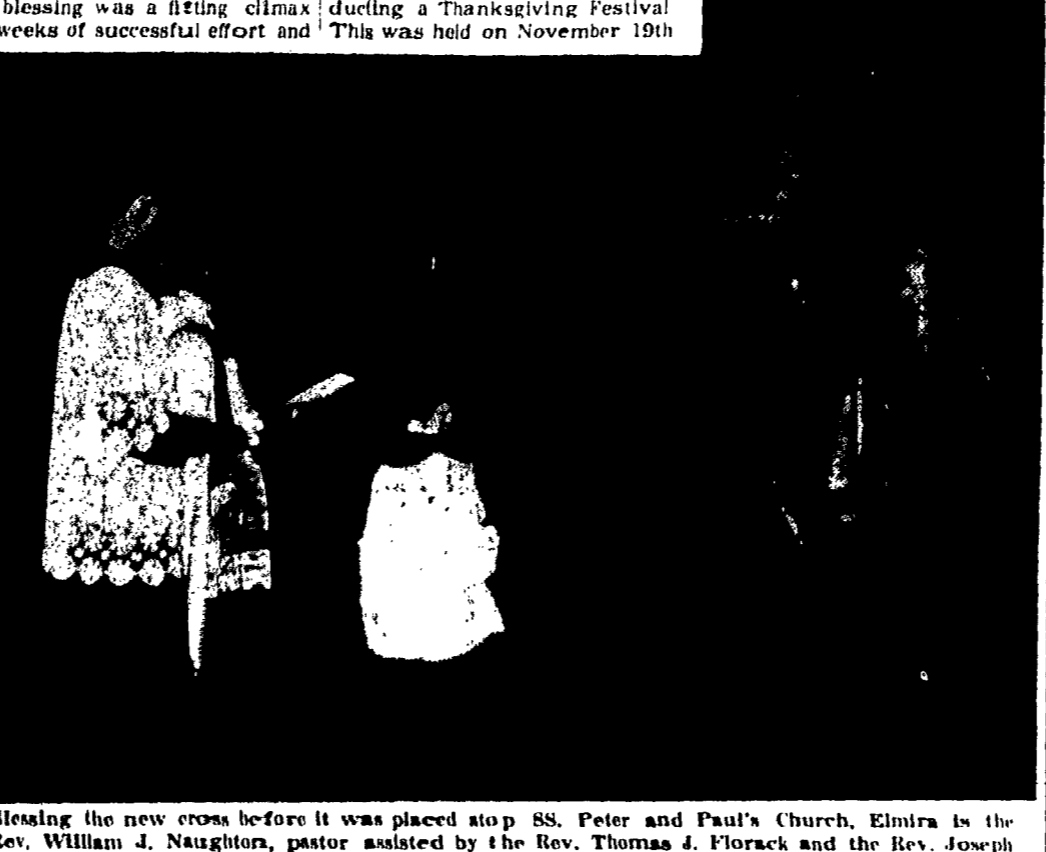
