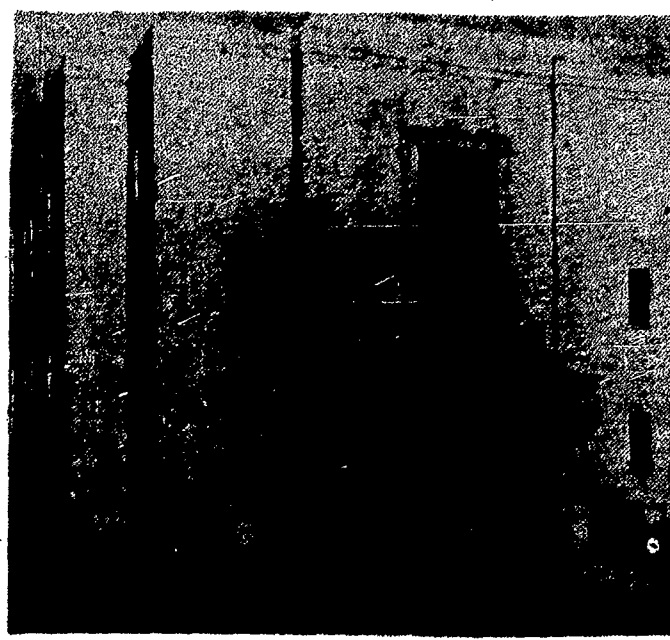

New Elmira Church-School To Be Dedicated Sunday

Dedication of the new St. Anthony's church and school will take place in Elmira Sunday at 11 o'clock with a Solemn High Mass, Coram Episcopo. The Most Rev. James E. Kearney, Bishop of Rochester will bless the newly erected \$250,000 structure that replaces the one destroyed by fire on Feb. 2, 1947.

A procession of the officers of the Mass, a Color Guard from St. Anthony's Post No. 1144 Catholic War Veterans, and an honor guard from Elmira Assembly, Fourth Degree Knights of Columbus will march from the rectory on Main Street at 10:45 a.m. and proceed to the main entrance on West Washington Avenue.

BISHOP KEARNEY will preside in the sanctuary. Officers to the Bishop are: Archpriest, Rt. Rev. Magr. William J. Brien, V.F.; Deacons, Rev. Arthur C. Smith and Rev. Thomas J. Toole; Master of ceremonies, Rev. John E. Maney; Officers of the Mass are: Rev. Albert L. Simonetti, celebrant; Rev. Charles J. Azzi, Deacon; Rev. Bernard C. Hanna, subdeacon; first Master, Rev. Ignatius St. George; second Master, Rev. John V. Loughlin.

The Mass will be broadcast over local station WELM and the Rev. Leo G. Schwab, pastor of Our Lady of Lourdes Church will be the narrator. The Chapel situated in the basement of the structure and having a seating capacity of 450, is beautifully appointed with a main Liturgical altar and two side altars. One dedicated to our Blessed Mother and the other to St. Anthony. A Dossal curtain of gold will hang at the rear of the main altar.

MAYOR AND Mrs. Strachen and President and Mrs. W. S. A. Pott of Elmira College will be among the guests of honor at the Mass. Since the fire, Masses have been celebrated each Sunday and on Christmas in Elmira College Chapel. This was made possible by the kind invitation from Dr. Pott and the trustees of Elmira College. Father Simonetti at last Sunday's Masses expressed deep gratitude to the college for their making possible the problem of aiding the parishioners to attend Masses in the immediate vicinity of the parish area.

A Solemn Triduum of Thanksgiving will open Sunday evening and will close on Wednesday noon, the Feast of the Immaculate Conception. There will be two services each evening, the first in Italian at 7 p.m. and the second in English at 8 p.m. The Triduum will be conducted by the Rev. William Baldassare O.F.M. Cap. of New York City. The building will be open on Sunday for public inspection immediately following the 11 o'clock Mass, and until 10 in the evening.
