N. Y. Sees Midnight Mass In First Televised Service

New York — (Special) — Christmas Eve Midnight Mass at St. Patrick's Cathedral, celebrated by Francis Cardinal Spellman, was broadcast on television for the first time over three television networks and a radio network through a special arrangement between the Cathedral and the television industry. The Rev. Charles F. Manu of the Cathedral staff was the narrator. The Cathedral Men's Choir was joined for the first time on the air by the 50 voices of the Boy Chorists of St. Patrick's. Recently organized and trained under the direction of the Rev. William T. Greene, archdiocesan chairman of music and a member of St. Patrick's staff, the choristers bring boys' voices back to the music of St. Patrick's Cathedral for the first time since before the war. They are from St. Ann's Academy, New York City.

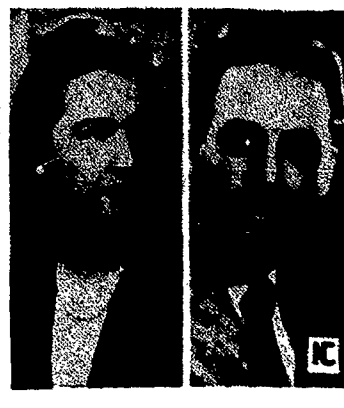

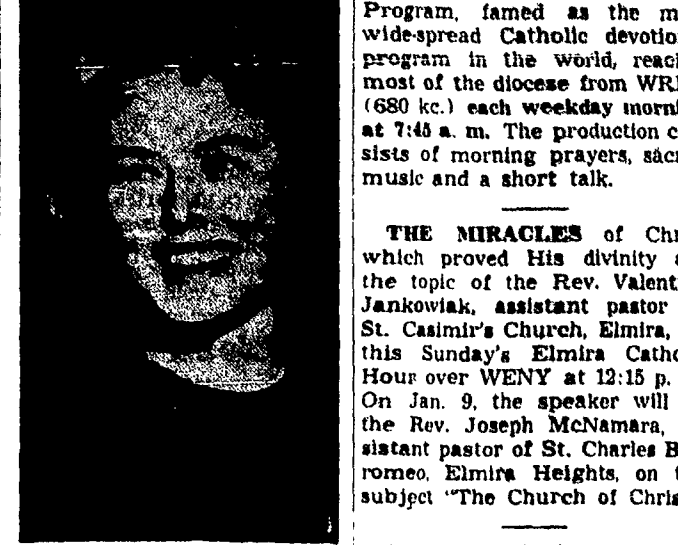

Bergman in 'Joan of Arc' Heads Sunday Air Shows

Ingrid Bergman will star in a radio-dramatization of her most recent film triumph when she plays 'Joan of Arc' on a new NBC series called 'Command Performance' over WHAM this Sunday evening at 8:30 p. m. Catholic critics have praised Miss Bergman's movie version of the French peasant girl who led her nation to victory over the English in 1430 and then died at the stake under condemnation by a church court. German Hierarchy Condemns New Anti-Religious Movie

Munich — (NC) — A German motion picture, "The Apple Is Off," has been condemned in an official statement issued by the Cologne central press office of the German Hierarchy.

The picture ridicules scenes of the Scriptures, notably of Genesis. Protestant spokesmen associated themselves with Catholic critics of the film. Its condemnation by the hierarchy followed a severely critical article written by the Rev. Max Grischneider, SJ, head of the Catholic motion picture bureau here. He charged that 90 per cent of all the movies now being shown in Germany preach a practical atheism.

A survey published by the central motion picture office at Cologne discloses that two post-war German productions, two of 92 American films and 28 of 117 French pictures are listed in categories 3 and 4, which correspond to "not to be recommended" and "condemned." None of the British and Swiss films are thus classified.

Father Grischneider said that since German pictures must be approved by the occupational authorities, "practically all responsibility for German films is in the hands of the occupational powers."

'Joan of Arc' Movie True, C. U. Priest Says

Washington — (NC) — The Rev. William J. Lallou, associate professor of sacred liturgy of the Catholic University of America, was one of the three Catholic clergymen who served as clerical technical advisors in the preparation of Walter Wanger's picture, 'Joan of Arc.' Others were the Revs. John J. Devlin of Los Angeles and Paul Donceur, S. J., of Paris. Every effort was made to insure historical accuracy throughout the film and liturgical and canonical fidelity in the portrayal of the Church scenes and the conduct of the trial, Father Lallou said. One of his contributions was the working out of the sequence of the coronation of Charles VII in accordance with medieval ritual for the uncrowning and crowning of the French kings.
