Radio Decency Improved, Says Collegians Poll

Rensselaer, Ind. — (NC) — Comedy programs on the air have attained a new high in decency, according to a report compiled by the Radio Acceptance Poll, which is conducted by the National Federation of Catholic College Students.

Rated as "highly acceptable" over the four-week period from Oct. 17 to Nov. 13 were the Life of Riley and Jack Benny shows. Eddie Cantor and Fred Allen followed with high "acceptable" ratings.

Also listed as "acceptable" were Red Skelton, Burns and Allen, Charlie McCarthy, Bob Hope, Phil Harris and Duff's Tavern.

The Fibber McGee and Molly show, sole radio comedy program to win a "highly acceptable" rating for the entire season last year, has been "graduated" from RAP and will not be monitored this season.

To compile its current report, first of the present listening season, RAP tabulated 8,213 votes on 1,620 ballots. Programs were confined to the basis of "good taste and all-around family acceptability."

Friars of Graymoor Plan Japan Work

Garrison, N. Y. — (NC) — The Graymoor Friars of the Society of the Atonement will open their first foreign mission late next month in Japan. It has been entered into with a 60-square-mile area in the Tokyo-Yokohama area, with headquarters at Tokushima Tokko highway.

The Society of the Atonement is a 50-year old community dedicated to the work of church unity and the missions. Although it has a number of home missions in this country and Canada, this is the first foreign mission entrusted to it.

The Friars recently established St. John Atonement Seminary at Montour Falls in the Diocese of Rochester.

Priest Plans Theatre and Radio Chains for Japanese

Tokyo — (RNS) — A chain of theatres which will show morally unobjectionable films is planned here by the Very Rev. Paul Marrellino, superior of the Pius Society of St. Paul.

The priest has enlisted the aid of Japanese politicians and financial leaders for the project.

First of the theatres will be erected in the Shinjuku area here and will seat 1,000 persons.

FATHER MARRELLINO is a prominent figure behind a plan to set up a chain of 11 radio stations from Mount Japan.
