96 Take K. of C. Scholarship Test

Ninety-six Catholic high school boys and girls took the examination Saturday for the scholarships offered by New York State Council, Knights of Columbus in the area covered by Rochester Council, according to Grand Knight John J. Kinney.

The examinations were given in Columbus Civic Center ballroom with the Rev. Walter A. Fischer and Richard Thiele acting as moderators.

In the whole state, 1,902 applications were received for the scholarship examinations according to James E. Lanigan of Fulton, state chairman.

The test on Jan. 15 was an aptitude and achievement test prepared by the Educational Testing Service. When the papers are graded, the top five candidates in each of the eight scholarship districts will take the final examination to be conducted by the College Entrance Examination Board at a date in April yet to be designated.

The winner in each district will be certified to the Scholarship Committee by the E.T.S. and the results will be announced at the annual State Convention.
