**Lay Groups Here Protest Card. Mindszenty Arrest**  
 Catholic groups in Rochester diocese, are rallying to the support of Cardinal Mindszenty and Archbishop Stepinac held in dungeons behind the Iron Curtain in Europe.  
 The Catholic Central Union of America, Rochester Branch in a resolution "protests the arrest and imprisonment of Cardinal Mindszenty by the Hungarian Government, and calls upon that government to cease its unlawful interference with the right of religious freedom of the Hungarian people."  
 The organization calls "upon the government of the United States of America to use all means in its power, including an appeal to the proper agency of the United Nations, to secure the release of Cardinal Mindszenty and the discontinuance of the present campaign in Hungary for the destruction of all things religious, and above all, to obtain for the people of the countries now occupied by troops of Soviet Russia, a return of the God-given personal rights of such peoples."  
 The protest was sent to the Hon. Robert A. Lovett, State Department, Washington, D. C.  
**AREA COUNCILS** of the Knights of Columbus are joining with the State Catholic Affairs committee in a protest registered with the President of the United States.  
 In the State K. of C. protest for 85,000 Knights it is stated: "It has been obvious for several months that only the Catholic Church stood between the Communists and their complete enslavement of the Hungarian people. The Church has been personified by Cardinal Mindszenty, an exemplar of loyalty to God and country."  
 "A short time ago it was Archbishop Aloysius Stepinac in Yugoslavia. His mock trial was a sacrilegious travesty on justice, and we let it pass without a public pronouncement from our government."  
 "We feel that the United States government should take a firm stand against these flagrant violations of the Atlantic Charter. Yalta and the rest."  
 "As loyal Catholic American citizens, we urge our government never to relax its efforts to help achieve and guarantee all men their God-given right."
