The communist regime introduced a bill to cut the ties of all Bulgarian churches with parent churches outside the country in order to preserve what was called the "canonical purity" of the various Bulgarian churches and "secure" their

liberty. This program of the Bulgarian regime resembles that enforced in neighboring Rumania, where the Eastern Rite Catholic Church has been forced into schism.


