### Hibernians Ask Severing Of Hungarian Diplomatic Tie

President Truman was urged to break off diplomatic relations with Hungary in a resolution passed by the Monroe County Chapter, Ancient Order of Hibernians and which was announced at the first annual Commodore John Barry dinner last Wednesday at the Hotel Seneca.

Martin M. Brophy, toastmaster, read the statement to the President and revealed that a resolution expressing opposition of the Hibernians to discriminatory legislation for education aid was also passed.

The Rev. Dr. Edward Lodge Curran of Brooklyn, state chaplain, told the large gathering that the United States should be the first loyalty of Americans above consideration of the United Nations. "The United Nations will continue to fail, he said, 'until Russia is told either to act like one of the United Nations or get out.'"

Donor Curran also called for outlawing of the Communist Party in the U.S. and barring from public office of any candidate known to be affiliated with the Communists.

Introducing the speaker was the Rev. Michael P. O'Brien, Monroe County A.O.H. chaplain. Other speakers were the Rt. Rev. Msgr. William M. Hart, P. A. V. G. Vicemayor Frank E. Van Lare, John Crowley, Mrs. Bridget Shannon, Children's Court Judge Thomas Neagher and Edward O'Neill of Syracuse.

### Tolerance Theme Of Fr. Ehmann's Talk To CDA Unit

Corning—Tolerance, its shades and meanings, was the theme of the talk given by the Rev. Benedict Ehmann, pastor of St. Mary's of the Lake Church, Watkins Glen, before more than 150 members and guests of Corning St. Joseph's Catholic Daughters of America at the 38th annual banquet of the organization at the Baron Steuben Hotel Sunday evening.

"If you take tolerance to mean merely putting up with one another, they are called upon to show more than tolerance. It is not a compliment to be merely tolerated as an odd character in a neighborhood is tolerated. That is not the kind of tolerance which good Catholics should either give or receive. It falls far short of the Christian love which should be a fulltime aim of all our living," said Father Ehmann.
