New York—The City of Kings, a new play by the Rev. Urban Nagle, O.P., which deals with the life of Blessed Martin de Porres, a mulatto holy man of sixteenth century Peru, has received the generous praise of New York's major theater critics.

Produced by the Blackfriars Guild at their theater on 57th Street on Feb. 17, the new dramatic offering has been hailed as "an inspiring play about a kindly, sympathetic, humble and great apostle of mercy and goodwill."

Viennese Crowd Church To Hear Colonel's Mass

Vienna, Austria — (NC) — Every evening at 5:30 crowds of gaunt, poorly-clothed Austrians press into musty old heritage Dreiergassekirche, or Holy Trinity Church here where Beethoven once served as organist.

The priest is Mgr. Roman J. Nauer, Lieutenant Colonel in the Army and senior chaplain for United States Forces in Austria (USFV). He was pastor of St. Joachim's Church, Buffalo, N. Y. until he went off to war in 1918 and served in Hawaii, Australia and in the Invasion of New Guinea.

AN IMPRESSIVE, stocky man with nearly white hair and a deep, hearty voice, Monsignor Nauer is one of the best known Americans in Vienna. He is popular among the Austrians as among his own countrymen.
