**St. Francis Movie Set At Immaculate March 22**

The sound movie "St. Francis of Assisi" will be presented Tuesday evening, Mar. 22 at 8:30 p. m. in Immaculate Conception auditorium after Lenten devotions in the church.

Proceeds of the movie, which is the second in a series of three, will be used in the purchase of new books. Many books have been obtained with the proceeds from the picture shown two weeks ago.

AMONG THESE are "The Life of Christ" by Ricciotti and "The Greatest Story Ever Told," by Ourisler, which brings the number of books on the Life of Christ in the library to fifteen. The recently published "Procession of Saints" by James Broderick, S.J., stories of 15 little-known English Saints, along with Wain's "St. Peter, the Apostle," has been added to the biography shelves. Terminaries are reminded of the efficacy of practicing the Way of the Cross which has rich blessings attached. Says the Rev. Mark Regener, O.F.M., writing in the "Franciscan Forum": "The walking prayer of the Way of the Cross is very simple, with the simplest conditions for gaining the plenary indulgence granted for each performance. One must be (1) in the state of grace, (2) meditate on our Lord's suffering and death, (3) move from station to station, except in the case of a large congregation, (4) perform the devotion without a notable interruption. "By receiving Holy Communion the day on which we make the Stations another plenary indulgence can be gained; still another if the Stations are said ten times within a month. There are no further conditions."

**National Honors Awarded Papers Of Mercy High**

Two top-flight honors in the annual Columbia University Scholastic Press Association competition were captured by Our Lady of Mercy High School publications "The Mercedes" and "The Quill," the school has been informed. The medalist award was presented to "The Mercedes" as an outstanding magazine of the private secondary schools' class. "The Quill" took first place in the private secondary schools printed newspapers' class. Nazareth Academy's "The Gabriel" shared the first place award in the newspaper class, and "The Maroon and White" of Aquinas Institute came in second in the same classification. Some 3,500 students from 25 states attended the three-day program of conferences, clinics and lectures which opened last Thursday in New York City at Columbia. More than 1,000 publications from schools in 46 states, Canada, District of Columbia, Puerto Rico, Hawaii, Alaska, Egypt and Okinawa competed in the contests.
