## Camp Stella Maris Opens Registration For Season

Summer isn't far away when boys and girls begin thinking of camp, swimming, baseball, hikes and campfires.

To meet those summertime-dreams that begin in early

spring, Camp Stella Maris, the diocesan camp for boys and girls on Conesus Lake, 25 miles south of Rochester, opened its registration and information office this week in the Columbus Civic Center.

Announcing the summer schedule, camp officials listed four encampments for boys and one for girls. For boys: Encampment A

July 3 to July 9 (1 week); B July 10 to July 23; C July 24 to August 6; D July 7 to Aug. 13 (1 week).

Sole encampment for girls is Aug. 14 to Aug. 27.
