Catholics Score Sex Film Study

The committee bases its judgment on the belief that "classroom presentation of this subject to children violates principles of sound sex instruction, offends Christian modesty and is liable to leave grave consequences in its wake."
It is further charged that "Human Growth" may be "for many an occasion of sin because it may give rise to unwholesome curiosity in matters of sex."

"CONCERNING THE other film, "Human Reproduction," which is described as "extremely graphic," the Committee warns that "under no circumstances should this film be viewed by high school students."
The nature of the subject matter and the type of presentation in "Human Reproduction" should restrict its showing to "the married, those soon to be married, and adults to whom such information would be helpful," the Committee believes.

The Committee statement concludes with a caution to "Christian parents that the imparting of sex knowledge alone will not teach Christian chastity."
"Such knowledge is important and must be given to the individual according to need and maturity. But it is highly important for parents to inculcate Christian moral principles and attitudes which will restrain youth from undue curiosity and from the excesses of unbridled sexual appetites."

Sex Study Motion Picture Used in Rochester Schools

Benjamin Franklin, Charlotte, East and Jefferson High Schools have had the film, according to David Denmore, assistant superintendent of schools. They were shown, he said, to health and hygiene classes in the 10th, 11th and 12th grades and always to segregated groups of boys and girls as "a part of the regular health education curriculum."
"PRODUCED BY McGraw-Hill Publishing Company and introduced in the state by the New York State Department of Health for "parents and adults," the twenty-minute movie with a companion film, "Human Growth," has been viewed by many adult groups in Rochester and other parts of the diocese.
It reached the Rochester school system by loan from the Runder Memorial Library which maintains a large film library for use of community organizations.

"APPROVED FOR school use by the Department of Audio-Visual Education of the Rochester Board of Education, the movie was reviewed by several officials of Child - Services and Health Education sections of the Board. It was then made available to any school which requested it. Only four principals have permitted it to be shown thus far, Teacher-opinion in the high schools has been divided over the presentation and the content of the movie and the advisability of showing it for group-instruction without regard for the maturity and the individual needs of the pupils."

Red Party Line Aids Catholics

Rome - (CIP) - Communist propaganda agents are unwittingly helping the spread of Catholicism in the Peking area of China, according to the "Eldes" news agency.
A missionary just returned from Peking relates that many Chinese living high in the mountains close to the Mongolian border, which have been occupied by Communist forces, have never seen a Catholic priest, nor heard of the Catholic religion.
Their curiosity is aroused when Communist propaganda and education officials condemn the Church and its clergy in speeches following the usual Marxist line.

For many of these Chinese, the missionary declares, atheistic propaganda has been the first step towards conversion. They sought out a Catholic priest to learn about the religion which they had heard denounced by Communist agents.

Pope Pius XII Will Observe Golden Jubilee

IN ADDITION, the Pope was the first Pontiff ever to travel by air, to have visited both North and South America, to have received a personal representative of the President of the United States at the time of his coronation (Joseph P. Kennedy, then Ambassador to London), or to have received a personal representative of the American President with the rank of special envoy to the Vatican (Myron C. Taylor).

Pius XII is the first Pope whose election was announced directly from the Vatican by radio. He was the first to appoint as many as 32 cardinals at one time. The cardinals were proclaimed at Pius' first consistory in February, 1946, the preponderance of non-Italian majority was established the first time since the middle of the 14th century that a non-Italian majority was established in the Sacred College of Cardinals.

OTHER NOTABLE events of Pius XII's pontificate have been the modification of Canon Law to simplify the formalities of a Papal election; the establishment of a Chinese hierarchy; the organization of Vatican war relief efforts on a world-wide basis; and the issuance of notable pronouncements on such matters as Biblical research and study and the Catholic liturgy.

Since his coronation, Pope Pius has issued thirteen encyclicals - messages to the Universal Church - in addition to a large number of constitutions, motu proprio, and various other types of pronouncements.

His first encyclical was the historic Summi Pontificatus, dated October 30, 1939, in which he pointed to the need for unity in opposing world evils. His latest issued on October 23, 1948 (In Multiplicibus), urged renewed prayers for peace.

POPE PIUS has canonized eleven other saints besides St. Frances Xavier Cabrini - five of them French, three Italian, and one each Portuguese, Hungarian, and Swiss. During his reign he has named not less than 89 archbishops and bishops for this country - totalling nearly half of the American hierarchy at the present time.
Because of his public addresses and audiences, as well as his radio (and lately television) discourses, Pope Pius has been seen and heard by more people than any other Pope in history. Virtually every country and every type of occupation has been represented in the groups which have called at the Vatican to pay respects. In all his talks to these groups Pope Pius has stressed the special ways in which they can help in building international peace on sound moral foundations.

Named to Philippines
Rome - (RNS) - Monsignor Egidio Vagnozzi, chancellor of the Papal Internuncio in Delhi, India, has been named by Pope Pius XII as Apostolic Delegate to the Philippine Islands. He will leave for Manila after his consecration as Titular Arch-bishop of Mira.

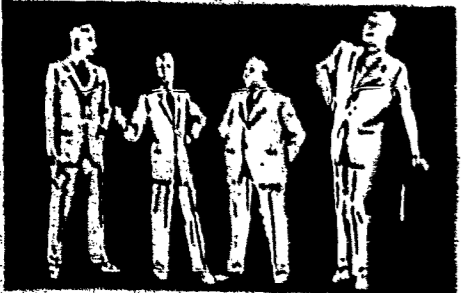
