Seeks Aid In U.S. For Lithuanians

near Council, the Lithuanian prelate warned that the Baltic states are being used by Russia in her preparations for war. "Moscow is preparing all the time for war and she is using the Baltic states as bases from which to launch her armies," he said.

Monsignor Krupavicius, who is president of the Supreme Lithuanian Committee of Liberation, pronounced agreement with Winston Churchill's recent deposition that the possession of the atom bomb by the United States was the one thing holding the Russians back militarily. When Russia has the atom bomb, he said, she will use it.

"MONDOW AND WASHINGTON are the two powers in the world today. Moscow cannot create any rivals. She will move when she is ready and no question of principles will stop her. The Lithuanian prelate declared.

He revealed that he had conferred with the State Department on his arrival in January on the possibilities of an attack launched out of the Baltic. He was not at liberty he said to reveal the details of the interviews.

Referring to the recent world peace conference of the 21,000 members of Axis Nations and Professions, Monsignor Krupavicius recommended that more of these meetings, generally thought to be Communist propaganda media, be held in America.

The conference was a school for Americans he said. A way for you to find out what Communism is like... its aims and plans... what it does to the world. Invite more of these meetings here. It will be an education for Americans.

THE PRELATE IS currently touring the United States to raise funds among Lithuanian groups such as St. George's congregation, to help the Committee of Liberation carry on underground in Lithuania. His record of opposition to the Soviets is long and bitter.

Founder of the Christian Democratic Party in Lithuania in 1917 during the Bolshevik Revolution, he was a leader in the battle for Lithuania's independence. Condemned to death for his activities, he escaped again in 1946, he was sentenced to death in absentia by the Soviets.
