Boston College Sets Exams On April 30

Applicants for admission to Boston College who are unable to take the entrance examinations on next Saturday April 9, because they are taking college board examinations on that day, will be permitted to take the Boston College entrance examinations on April 30, the college authorities announced today.

Over 100 applicants for admission to the college have already been received. Separate examinations will be given for admission to the college of business administration and the college of arts and sciences. Examinations will begin at 9:30 a.m. in the lower building and in the business administration building.

Examinations will consist of an aptitude test and four achievement tests. For the first time the college of business administration will offer mathematics examinations in three different categories, depending on the mathematics background of the applicant. Successful applicants will then be grouped with students of equivalent experience and will therefore be able to progress more rapidly in their future mathematical studies at the college of business administration.
