Women's Viewpoint A Meditation On Calvary

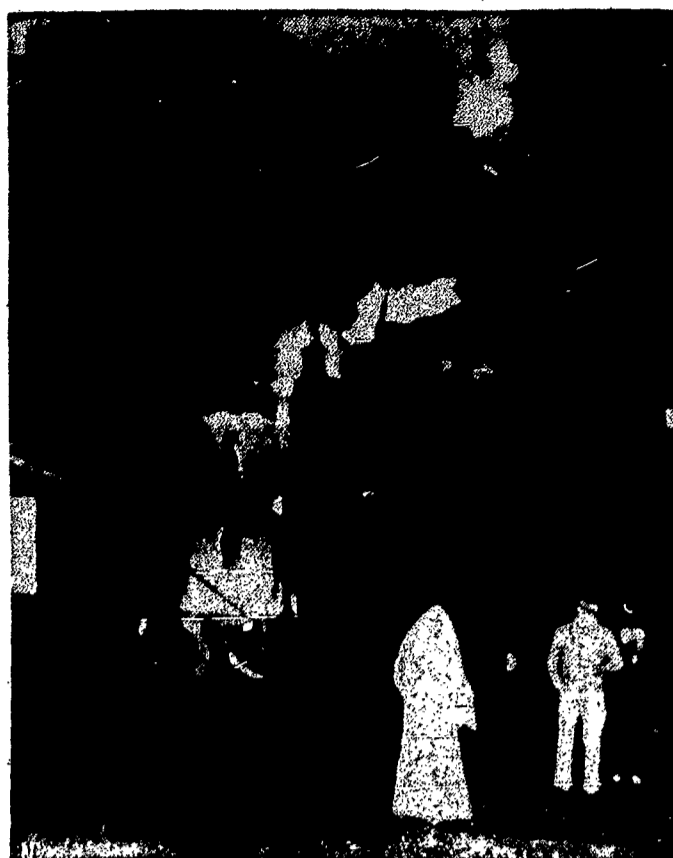
