

### Watertown K. C. Leads Bowlers in National Tourney

Bernie Quinn of Watertown is leading in two sections of the National Knights of Columbus Eastern Division bowling tournament having rolled a 653 series at Webber Hall, Rochester, Sunday.

He took the lead in the individual event and totaled 1,772 for his nine games to take first place in the all-events standings. Quinn's single games were 222, 236 and 195. He rolled 545 in the five-man and 524 in the doubles.

**PALMYRA COUNCIL'S** team took first place in team standing with 2,689 at Bdonomo's, while Quinn's team from Watertown held second place with 2,611.

John McGough and Tom Hoffman of Philadelphia led in doubles with 1,118. E. Costa and F. Sulzbach, Philadelphia were second with 1,094. Nick Amadio and Andy Sivak of Philadelphia were third with 1,077.

Second high in singles was Red Morrison, Philadelphia, 621 and third, Joe DiCarlo of Watertown, 613.

DiCarlo was second in all-events standings with 1,661, followed by Bob Yohey of Philadelphia, 1,643.

Rochester bowlers who rolled over 500 in 3 games were: Al Beach, Rochester No. 28, 606; Clarence Geschwind, Christopher, 586; Fred Brown, Admirals, 510; Sam Insalaca, Voyagers, 563; Dan McNally, Klutas, 510; Joe Leone, Rochester No. 30, 536.

The tournament will skip Easter weekend and resume on April 23 continuing week ends until May 15.
