**Women Hear Bishop Prior To Rome Visit**

Keep alight the torch "of our faith" in civic life and in your homes. His Excellency, Bishop Kearney spiritual director told members of the Catholic Women's Club at a dinner in Powers Hotel, Monday.

The dinner was in the nature of a farewell to the Bishop on the eve of his departure for the Vatican to make his Ad Limina Apostolorum visit. The club presented a check to the Bishop through its president, Mrs. Herbert J. Janick.

In expressing appreciation for the gift, the Bishop also emphasized the "outstanding generosity of you to our appeals," during the war and the reconstruction period. This was fully realized, the Bishop said, in the great response to the Bishops' War Relief appeal this year.

**BISHOP KEARNEY** told of being instructed in his duties as club spiritual director by the late Archbishop Thomas F. Hickey under whose guidance the club was organized. The Bishop reviewed diocesan activities during his reign and expressed satisfaction with the report he is going to make to the Holy Father on the Diocese of Rochester.
