The 944 teachers in all diocesan schools are divided as follows: Diocesan priests, 23; religious orders of men, 38; religious orders of women, 839; lay teachers 44. OTHER POINTS highlighted in the Annual School Report v'ere :

During the past year the Diocesan School Film Library circulated 153 films among 31 schools. Seven teachers from various religious communities are currently pursuing courses in audio-visual education,

A total of 1,659 children of diocesan schools received hometo school transportation at public expense during the school year 1947-48.

During the same year school children contributed \$38,894 to the Foreign and Home Missions, for pollo relief.

VISITATION REPORTS show that all diocesan schools received community health services, in. cluding audiometer and otological examinations, medical examinations, school nursing services and dental inspections.

Five State scholarships were earned by last June's graduates, as were 16 scholarships to Catholle colleges.
