**Tito and Moscow United in Church War, Says Paper**  
Vatican City — (NC) — Commenting on press reports that seven Jesuit Fathers have been sentenced to jail in Ljubljana, capital of Slovenia in Yugoslavia, *Osservatore Romano* refers to the sentences as proof of continued religious persecution in that country. The split between members of the Cominform does not affect their common enmity toward everything Catholic, the paper remarks.  
ACCORDING TO the press reports, the Jesuits were sentenced to prison terms from 2 to 12 years on charges of helping other Jesuits escape from Yugoslavia and maintaining relations with them after they reached Rome.  
They were also accused of having directed the work of Catholic Action in Gorizia during 1943-44, of having been engaged in anti-Yugoslav propaganda, and of having collaborated in the spring of 1943, with the R. V. Ventura Tachis, special Pujali envoy to Ljubljana.  
*Osservatore* said in comment that any state in the world that is persecuting religion could trump up similar charges.

**Army Officers Enroll in Tokyo Catholic College**  
Tokyo — (NC) — A total of 298 new students, the highest number in the history of the school, have been accepted for the first-year course at the Catholic University of Tokyo. Not included among these are some 80 students enrolled for evening sessions which have now been organized for adult groups wishing to complete their studies for a degree or just to improve themselves.  
The courses in the evening sessions are taught in English and about three-fourths of the students are American Army officers serving with the local occupation forces.

TRUTH — the terror of the Communists.  
In his article in *Look*, Cardinal Spellman explains the importance of the Pope's war on Communism. He writes:  
"In his war against atheistic Communism Pope Pius XII has neither military armies nor armaments, for his is a spiritual crusade: his armaments are the weapons of wisdom and justice and truth, his armies the God-loving peoples of the earth. Armed only with God's grace and a martyr's will, the Holy Father stands ready in the shedding of his heart's blood to become seed for the redemption and rebirth of those nations now enslaved."  
"The Pontiff's fears and sorrows are for all persecuted peoples — Protestants, Jews and Catholics alike — who, weakened by starvation, sickness and fear, have become victims of the Marxist cult of atheistic communism."  
TOO MANY Americans have cynically assumed that the Papal crusade against atheistic communism is merely a self-interested campaign on the part of the Pope to save only Catholics from Moscow's political system.  
This view is a tragic mistake. The Pope — Europe's bravest figure in this grim hour — is battling to save the whole world from atheistic tyranny. It was his voice during the past decade, and the voice of Pius XI before him, that warned the world so prophetically against this day of the Iron Curtain.  
Today when many statesmen are strangely silent, the voice of Pius XII is still vigorously raised in behalf of those millions who now live enslaved in the shackles of godless despotism.  
COMMUNISM IS desperately in need of silence to cloak its operations. Communists will pay any price to silence the free voices daring to expose their crimes. That's why, as Cardinal Spellman explains, "Pope Pius urges us to raise our voices against the enslavement of peoples everywhere; for one tactic of Communism, fatal to freedom, is to make men fear publicly to proclaim the truth and to protest against cruelty, tyranny and injustice."  
Cardinal Spellman is anxious that Americans, at least, will not make the mistake "fatal to freedom" of silently forgetting the millions now under Communist oppression.  
"What," he asks, "has happened to the hearts of free men that they can be so soon unmindful of the sacrifices made by Cardinal Mindszenty, Archbishop Stepienac, Bishop Ortigas and countless hosts of other innocents?"  
"For weeks now the name of Cardinal Mindszenty has almost completely disappeared from the news."  
NO DOUBT Cardinal Spellman's *Look* article will earn him fresh attacks from the Communists, who apparently recognized better than others the danger of truth to their cause.  
Humanly speaking, the millions suffering on the rack of Red tyranny have one hope, and that is the record of public truth voiced again and again by churchmen like Pope Pius and Cardinal Spellman. And by ordinary citizens like you and me.

THE GLEN SPRINGS will be used as a school to prepare young men for the Holy Priesthood, but other students will be accepted. The institution will be known as St. Anthony Minor Seminary and High School.  
The Most Rev. James E. Kearney, Bishop of Rochester has approved the establishment of the new high school and seminary.  
Beside St. Andrew's Seminary, the new St. Anthony Seminary will make seven schools in the diocese for preparatory studies for the priesthood. Others are: Capuchin Father Novitiate, Geneva; St. John Atorment Seminary of the Franciscan Friars of the Atonement, Whitefriars, Montour Falls; Irish Carmelites Novitiate, Auburn; St. Michael's Mission House of the Society of the Divine Word, Hemlock Lake, and St. Basil's Novitiate of the Basilian Fathers, Rochester.  
IMMEDIATE STEPS "will be taken immediately to meet a curriculum which will meet the State Regents requirements. This will enable other students than those preparing for the priesthood to attend the school," a spokesman for the order said following the purchase.  
Dedication services for the new institution are being planned for September. This fall, freshmen and sophomore classes will be established. By next year, a full high school course will be offered.  
A faculty for the new school, a permanent superior of the monastery and a rector of the new high school will be named by the

McMahon countered with the statement that "I cannot see any essential difference between fixing a child's teeth and giving him a ride on a bus."  
SENATOR DONNELL made a lengthy speech in support of his amendment, quoting from *The Christian Century*, the minority opinion in the New Jersey school bus case and Justice Frankfurter's opinion in the McCollum case to back his position that the provision of some public help to private schools would ultimately wreck the U. S. public school system.  
He said that the "vague and uncertain" language of the Thomas Bill might open the way for some help to sectarian schools, and that "from the standpoint of the interest of the nation itself, from the standpoint of the sectarian schools themselves, which do not want and which should not want governmental interference of any kind, the amendment, which confines the use of the funds to public schools, should be adopted."  
Although the Senate approved the Thomas Bill by a large majority, it spent five days debating the measure. Nearly a dozen amendments were introduced to change the bill, as it came from committee but all were defeated.
