### Fleming Altar Group Holds Annual Dinner

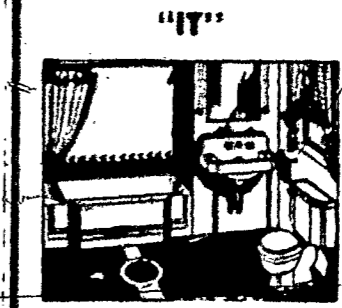
