Canisius Grads Told Measure Of Education

The good effects of your Christian education will be measured only in terms of how much service you can give to society," the Rev. Dr. Charles J. Mahony, Superintendent of Rochester Diocese Schools, told graduates of Canisius College in his baccalaureate address Saturday in Buffalo.

Pointing out that love of God depends on how much you love your neighbor, Dr. Mahony reminded the class: "You have not been educated and prepared for the society of the Social Register, but you have been educated for the society of this Twentieth Century bedeviled by social and economic ills for which Christian social principles are the sole remedy."

The Rochester educator warned the young men that economic achievement should not be the sole criterion of success and called upon them to examine thoroughly the particular profession or vocation which they had chosen to find out how they could best serve God and society.

He appealed to them not to allow their youthful idealism to be nullified by their adult environment.

"Youth has no vested interest in preserving a status quo that is evil. Don't be afraid of your youth. Let your youth be critical of your environment but don't let it overcome or overwear by it.

"Reject outright in the adult world and adult environment that which is to be rejected. Accept and renew and restore in Christ, that which is to be accepted and renewed and restored."
