Mich. Governor Signs Bus Bill

Lansing, Mich. (RNS) — Over the protest of several Protestant and Jewish groups, Gov. G. Mennen Williams signed the Phillips Bill yesterday.

PROTESTS WERE registered to the governor's signature including representatives of the Michigan Council of Churches, the American Jewish Congress, the Michigan Congregational Conference, and the Michigan Committee to Maintain the Separation of Church and State.

EXISTING LAW, adopted in 1943 permits a school district, within its boundaries, to transport parochial pupils along with those attending public schools.

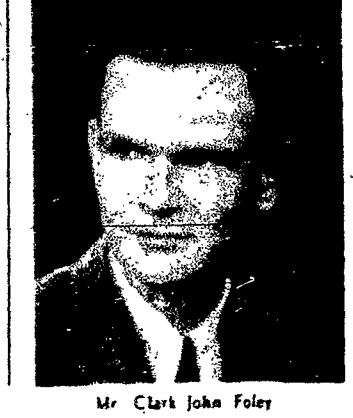
