

Moscow Has Aliens In Key U. S. Party Posts, Budenz Tells Senate

Washington — (AP) — The Communist Party in the United States is directed exclusively by aliens, and this is no accident, Louis F. Budenz testified before a Senate committee here.

"It is the fixed design of Moscow to employ aliens in the most responsible positions in every country. This is the nature of the party, and this is the nature of the party," he said.

"The Communist Party organization in this country, which is the Fifth Column of Soviet Russia in our midst, is a tool in the hands of the alien," he said.

"The roots are the political, economic, and social conditions which exist in the United States, and the Party is a tool which is used to exploit these conditions," he said.

Conservatism makes wide use of the tactic of hiding behind the foreign-born, converting the ingrained American sympathy for immigrants and refugees into a cloak to hide its subversive coming and goings, he said.

At one point in his testimony, the former Daily Worker editor told how various Communist leaders were assigned to work with the hyped-up American groups in this country. He said that

when it was learned that his mother's name was Sullivan, he was given the task of penetrating Irish-American organizations. He did not say what progress he made.

He also stated categorically that the motion picture "Blockade," which dealt with the Spanish civil war, was written by the Hollywood screen writer John Howard Lawson on direct orders of the political committee of the United States Communist Party.

Father Lombardi Preaches 'Crusade of Love' in Paris

Paris — (RNS) — Crowds of Catholics gathered at the Orly airport here to welcome Father Riccardo Lombardi, famous Italian Jesuit, whose Crusade of Love has gained him an extraordinary reputation in his native country.

The priest arrived with a status of Our Lady of Loretto, which is a copy of an original statue blessed by Pope Pius XII, and which will be presented to the Italians of Paris by French Catholics.

Although Italian emigrants excitedly awaited the status, they were more anxious to see Father Lombardi. The frail, Neapolitan Jesuit, who is barely 40, has been taken on many occasions as a new St. Francis of Assisi.

After the Italian liberation, Father Lombardi started a series of preaching tours which have taken him all over Italy and into Vienna. Everywhere his simple words explaining the Gospel and

expounding the love of Christ have moved his hearers to tears and repentance.

Father Lombardi's inspiration comes to him during long hours of prayer during which, it is said, he often loses consciousness. Over 100,000 persons have gathered at a time to hear him, and his recent sermons were delivered at airfields because more ample facilities were not available.

Father Lombardi has no money, no home, and no means of transport. Nevertheless, he has never been late for an engagement, and food, shelter, and transportation have always been found for him. "I leave it to Jesus," is the only explanation the priest gives.

During his stay in Paris he will preach at the Church of St. Sulpice and from the pulpit of Notre Dame Cathedral. Special arrangements are being made to handle the vast crowds expected to flock to his sermons.

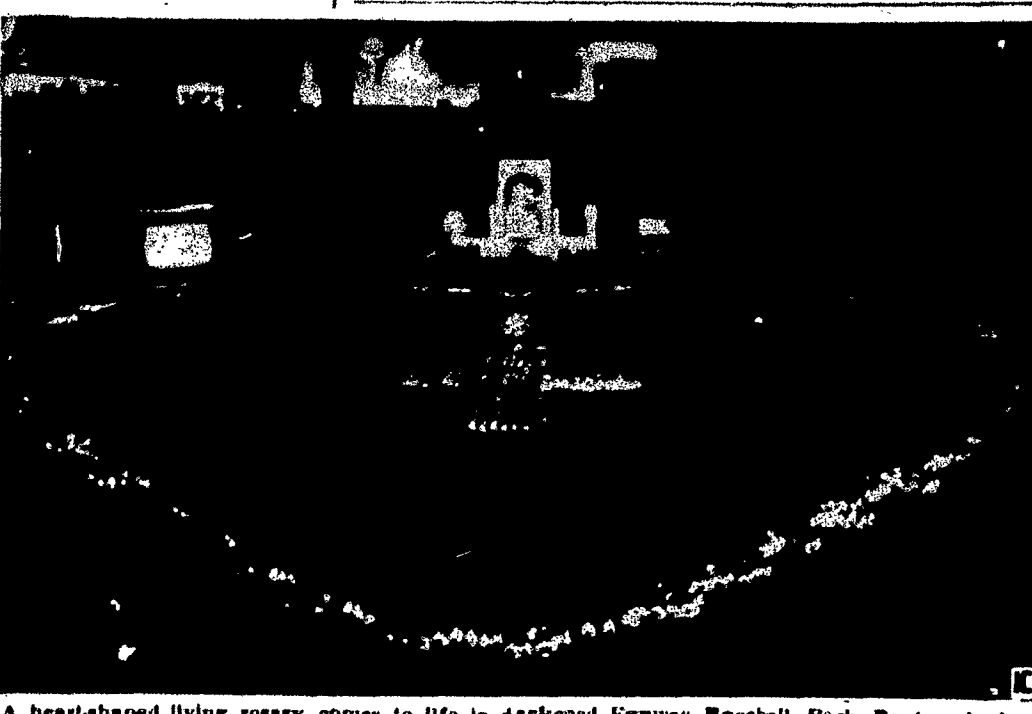

Polish Bishop Reveals Arrest Of Six Priests

New York — (NC) — Lack of any objective news in the government-controlled press on the arrest of six priests of the Katowice diocese, Auxiliary and Vicar General of the diocese, to issue a circular letter to tell his clergy of the circumstances surrounding the arrests and trials of the priests. THE CIRCULAR was issued, in its own words, "because of the ever growing interest of the Catholic community in the fate of six diocesan priests, who have been arrested in connection with the reading of the last pastoral letter or with the placing of crucifixes in schools."

The letter tells of the trial of one priest, the Rev. Leopold Pietroszek, and two members of Our Lady's Sodality, stating that they were beaten by Security police into signing confessions. They were accused of breaking into a school, removing pictures of Communist leaders and replacing the crucifix. The priest was accused of inciting them to that action.

Czesochowa, Polish Shrine, Hit By Reds

New York — (NC) — The Polish Communist regime has launched a campaign to eliminate Czesochowa, site of the Polish national shrine of Our Lady, as a pilgrimage center, the Inter-Catholic Press Agency here reports.

The ancient shrine is the most famous Marian center in Poland and has a picture of the Blessed Virgin painted on cypress wood which is reputed to be the work of St. Luke the Evangelist. Hundreds of thousands have gathered there during national pilgrimages.

The government's campaign began with a series of articles and radio reports depicting Czesochowa as an example of superstition and backwardness and characterizing its inhabitants as reactionaries and clericalists, the agency says.

Wide play was given to "demands" that "superstitious" pilgrimages to the center be restricted and that the small businesses selling religious articles there be closed.

At the same time the regime has forced changes in the municipal council, giving important posts to staunch communists, who are now charged with bringing the social structure of the city in line with the Communist pattern.

Czechoslovakia, Top Egyptians Honored For Church Aid By Holy Father

Cairo, Egypt — (NC) — The presentation of papal decorations on some of Egypt's leading citizens highlighted the second anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between Egypt and the Holy See.

The awards, which ranged from the Grand Cross of the Order of Pius IX to the Pro Ecclesia et Pontifice medal, were made by Archbishop Arthur Hughes, Papal Internuncio.

AMONG THOSE receiving the decorations were Abdel Hadi Pasha, the Egyptian Prime Minister; Talaat Pasha, grand chamberlain of the King's court; Ambassador Fahry Pasha; Mrs. Boulad, who has been instrumental in propagating Christianity through the country's press.

Also Mrs. Sidarous Pasha, wife of a leading Coptic rite Catholic, and Abdel Rahim Pasha, Egyptian Ambassador to the United States who served as Undersecretary of the Foreign Office when diplomatic relations between the Vatican and Egypt were established.

THE ORDER of Pius IX was set up in 1847 by Pope Pius IX as a recognition for outstanding deeds performed for the Church and society and may be bestowed on non-Catholics as well as Catholics.

Addressing the gathering Archbishop Hughes stated that diplomatic relations were established with the aim of uniting the efforts of Egypt and the Vatican for securing world peace and welfare. Calling Egypt the

Pontiff Warns Scientists On False Cancer Cure Reports

VATICAN CITY — His Holiness Pope Pius XII unfavorably criticized imprudent announcements of "sensational discoveries" and "radical victories" in the fight on cancer as compared with quiet, patient scientific research, which will one day merit the gratitude of future generations.

The Holy Father made the remarks in addressing a number of world authorities gathered here for a study week on the "biology of cancer" under the auspices of the Pontifical Academy of Sciences.

"When, from time to time," said Pope Pius, "news of a sensational discovery bringing at long last radical and definite victory over this implacable destroyer is imprudently announced, there only follow, alas, for those who are deceived and who even ask illusion, yet another disappointment deeper and crueler than those that have gone before."

Praising the other method of quiet and patient research, as more modest and elevated, the Holy Father told the scientists: "You who have been engaged for many years in the conscientious study of cancer, its manifestations and symptoms, its nature and causes, or at least, the conditions of its origin and development, intend, each in his own sphere but in constant contact with each other, to continue step by step your advance to the light in whose radiance you will seek more easily and happily to discover first of all a remedy that will prevent or alleviate, with the hope of preparing for the final victory of the discovery of a treatment that will cure."

Outlining the contributions to this ultimate victory of investigation and research, "which the public generally fails to appreciate," His Holiness expressed his pleasure and approval of the objective of the academy's efforts.

LOUIS BUDENZ

Mr. Budenz appeared before a Senate Judiciary committee headed by Sen. Pat McCarran of Nevada which is considering a bill to tighten U. S. immigration laws against subversive aliens. He came down from New York, where he is a professor at Fordham University, to testify.

At the moment, Budenz is providing a number of agents who have been busy, he said, naming Gerhard Richter, now in Communist Party, J. V. Fera, now in Hungary, and John Smith, now in Romania. He said that the Kremlin will gladly reimburse the Civil Rights Congress for the \$2,500 it lost when Hitler jumped his bail, because Hitler, who was the No. 1 Communist in the United States, is worth much more to the Reich.

Mr. Budenz said that those by whom he was being recruited for two purposes: to "train new cadres and subversive agents for the United States" and to organize a propaganda barrage against the U. S. in their own countries. He told the Senators he expects an influx of new spies and saboteurs into the country, all of whom aliens.
