Far East Needs 1000 Catholic Native Leaders

New York - (NC) - "One housand native leaders can save the Church in the Far East." the Rev. Emmanual Jasques, Belgian missioner, who recently arrived here from Louvain. Belgian has estimated. Father Jacques belongs to the Mission Heipers, a Beigian community whose members serve as dincesan priests under native Bishops in the Far East. He is stationed in Viet Nam in Inde-China.

"COMMUNIST VICTORIES IN China only emphasize the need for native Catholic leaders in Asiatic countries," he said. "We need them for the present struggic against communism, and for the future rebuilding of Far Eastern countries on a Christian

THIS LACK OF native leaders caused the Vietnamese Highops to assign Father Jacques the task of placing students in foreign universities for training. The missioner aiready has arranged for Vietnamese students to study in Paris and at the Catholic University of Louvain, Belgium,

"Viet Nam has a higher proportion of Catholick 2,000,000 out of a 20,000,000 population, than any other country in the Far East except the Philippines," Father Jacques said.
