Mr. Devereaux was a retired policeman who left the service in November, 1924. He was a member of the Police Benevolent Association, the Police Veterans' Association and the Blessed Sacrament Holy Name Society.

Born in Rochester, he was educated in St. Patrick's Cathedral School. He was appointed a patrolman in the Police Bureau in April, 1900 and served his first assignment at Police Headquarters. Transferred to the Franklin St. Station later, he was on morning duty in the Main E. St. Paul and Bausch street sector for about 22 years. After the village of Charlotte was incorporated into the city, he was one of the first patrolmen to be assigned to duty at the Stutson Street station.

Monsignor Koch Returns From The Philippines

Colonel Joseph K. Koch, Chief Chaplain of the U. S. Army Philippine Command, has returned to the United States for reassignment, following completion of more than two years service in the Far East, it was announced by the Public Information Office, PHILCOM Headquarters in Baguio City.

Col. Koch departed from Manila June 12, aboard the U. S. Army Transport General Simon D. Buckner. He will assume his new position with Headquarters, First Army at Governors Island, N. Y., upon his arrival in the States.

THE ROCHESTER BORN priest began his Army career in March 1928. Since then he has made three tours of duty in the Philippines, being assigned in Corregidor in 1929, Stenberg General Hospital in Manila in 1933, and to Headquarters, Philippines-Ryukyus Command, also in Manila in 1947. His other previous assignments include Fort Okla., Army Medical Center, Washington, D. C.; Fort Benning, Ga.; Panama Canal Zone; XXXIII Corps; and Hq. Fourth Army.

Col. Koch attended St. Andrew's Seminary, St. Bernard's Seminary, Rochester, and St. Thomas Theological Seminary, Denver, Colo., and Catholic University in Washington, D. C. He also completed the advanced course, Army Chaplains' School at Fort Devens, Mass.

Col. Koch is a native of Rochester. He was made Domestic Prelate with the title Right Reverend Monsignor by Pope Pius XII. Monsignor Koch has three sisters in Rochester, Mrs. Florence J. O'Connell, Mrs. John Wozniak and Mrs. Charles Vockel and a brother, Albert Koch.
