The order followed the recent Pentecost message of His Eminence Conrad Cardinal von Preysing, Bishop of Berlin, and a protest by the Berlin Protestant Bishop, Martin Dibelius, against the persistent indoctrination of public school children in the Soviet zone of occupation with Marxist doctrine.
