Saxony Red Regime Orders Closer Spying On Churches

Frankfurt (NC)—The communist Department of the Interior of the state of Saxony has ordered more strict police surveillance of Church activities. The order followed the recent Pentecost message of His Eminence Conrad Cardinal von Preysing, Bishop of Berlin, and a protest by the Berlin Protestant Bishop, Martin Dibelius, against the persistent indoctrination of public school children in the Soviet zone of occupation with Marxist doctrine.
