Long ages had come and gone since the fall of man and the expulsion of Adam and Eve from Paradise...

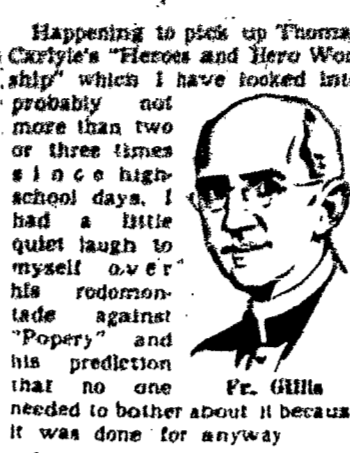
Faith is a needed virtue, the virtue by which we firmly believe in God and in all that God reveals...

Too Bad Thomas Can't Come Back

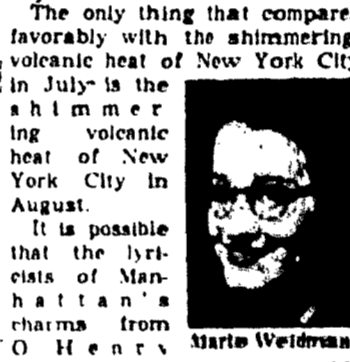
VERY WELL. Take a half century. To be doubly generous, take a whole century. Carlyle wrote in 1840. In 1833 came the Oxford Movement...
