### St. Bona Grads Hear Talk On Social Justice

St. Bonaventure, N. Y. — Addressing those who are striving to establish the status quo in America, Dr. Egon Plager, professor of sociology at Siena College, called for "practical social justice for all" and "security for society as a whole."

The 31-year-old, Viennese-born educator delivered the baccalaureate address at the summer commencement Sunday, August 7, of St. Bonaventure College, which conferred on him the honorary degree of Doctor of Laws. Seventy-five graduates and undergraduate students also received degrees in ceremonies presided over by Rt. Rev. Mgr. James M. Powers of Erie, Pa. Two other doctorates were conferred, one on Mgr. Powers, Doctor of Laws, and another Doctor of Letters, on Mother M. Ignace Holius of the Netherlands, Superior General of the Sisters of St. Francis of Penance and Christian Charity.

"WE MUST SEEK to it that measures are made to make social justice practical, and to bring security to the multitude," Dr. Plager declared. "The industrial might of America must serve the multitude. Business must develop a social consciousness and be aware of its community responsibilities. We must rid ourselves of our race prejudices and we must care for the needy."

"They are produced by us in our inhuman economic practices," he asserted; adding "if men can create depressions, then men can avoid depressions through economic planning and both statesmanship.
