Corning - Two candidates received the first degree in the Corning Council Knights of Columbus at the K of C Home. They were Joseph Paris and Robert Box.

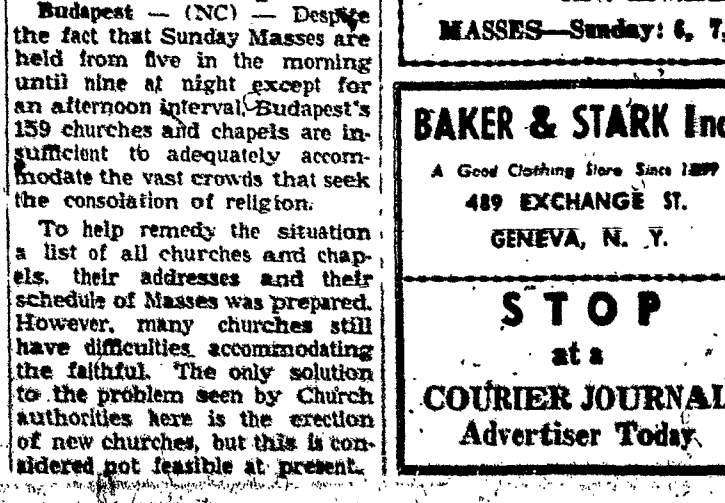
