6,500 Unemployed Canadians Pray in Public for Jobs

Sorel, Quebec — (RNS) — With 60 to 65 per cent of Sorel's approximately 8,000 workers unemployed, 6,500 persons gathered in Sorel arena to pray for jobs.

The mass demonstration of faith occurred at a service attended by officials of the Catholic Workers' League and led by the local Roman Catholic clergy. THIRTY-FIVE priests heard confessions from nearly 6,000 during the five-hour service.

Three Rivers, Que. — (NC) — The Grey Nuns of the Cross of Ottawa will establish a 100-bed hospital at nearby Cap de la Madeleine, site of the shrine in honor of Our Lady of the Rosary. The hospital will be known as the Cloutier Hospital in honor of the late Bishop F. Cloutier.

International Catholic Youth Leader Here

New York — (RNS) — Mile. de Hemptinne, president of the International Federation of Catholic Youth, arrived at Hoboken, N. J., on the New Amsterdam to begin a lecture tour of the United States and to visit various educational and social centers.

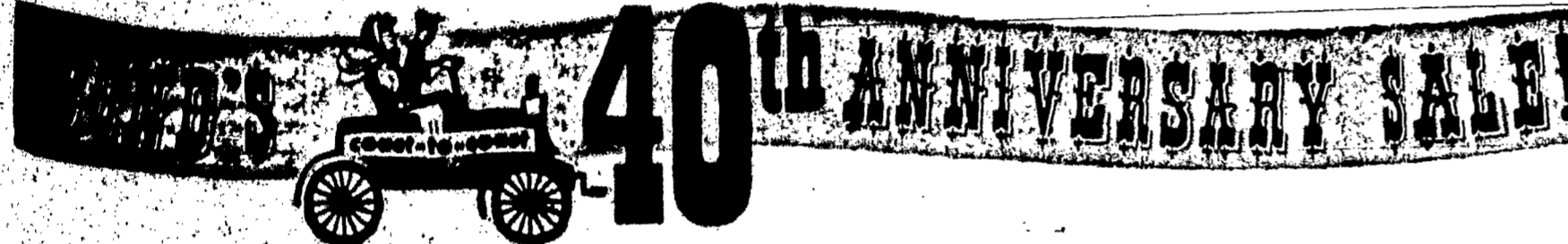
