State K.C. Head To Preside At Corning Meet

Corning A combined regional meeting to be conducted by State Deputy Matthew Kennedy of New York and a Central New York Chapter meeting with Chairman George T. White of Utica presiding will be held in Corning Knights of Columbus Council Home, Sunday, Oct. 9.

The meeting is expected to bring representatives of 35 councils in the Rochester and Syracuse diocesan areas. Chairman White will open the meeting at 2 p.m.

THIS WILL BE the new State Deputy's first visit to a subordinate council and will be the first session of its kind to be held in Corning.

Following a conference in New York City last Saturday Chairman White and District Deputy Frank K. Rhode of Elmira, announced that all district deputies of Central New York voted to accept an invitation from Grand Knight Joseph J. Sweet to meet in Corning.

White will be accompanied by the following other Central New York Chapter officers: Vice Chairman, Eugene F. Agan of Elmira; Secretary, James J. Fitzgerald of Utica; Treasurer, William J. Nix of Cortland; Warden, Robert J. Kinley of Elton; Inside Guard, P. J. Molinari of Oswego; Outside Guard, J. L. Wright of Auburn. The Rev. Daniel E. Lawler of Utica will officiate as chaplain.

Grand Knight Sweet stated that William E. Burke of Utica, past state deputy and now Supreme Director of the Order will probably attend as will State Warden Rocco F. Natale of Rochester.

Lutheran Spokesman Asks Aid To Parochial Schools

New York (NC) - A demand that Lutheran parochial schools be included in any social service program for schools was made here by an official of the Lutheran Church, Missouri Synod. The demand was made by the Rev. Oswald C. J. Hoffmann, director of synod's public relations, while speaking at the dedication of a parochial school attached to St. John's Lutheran Church here.

"WE SHALL NOT stand idly by if our children are denied welfare benefits not connected with our instructional program simply because they attend a Lutheran school," the Lutheran spokesman said. At the same time he pointed out that "even though we are paying our full share of taxes for education, we are not asking for state support of our school systems."

Dr. Hoffmann's demand that social services be extended also to parochial school children in a federal-aid-to-education legislation reiterated the stand taken by another synod official during a congressional hearing on such legislation.
