**Diocese School Heads Slated For Lectures**

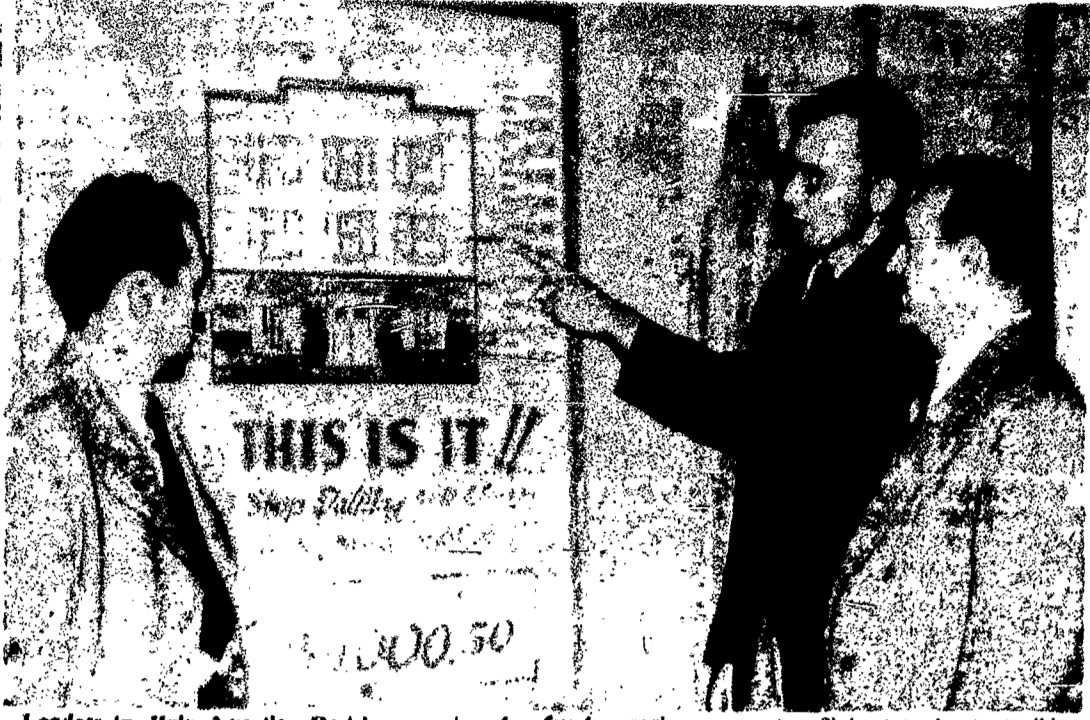
