KNIGHTS HONOR COLUMBUS

K. of C. Urged To Back Catholic School System

Knights of Columbus were called on to support, with ever increasing numbers, Catholic education in their community by speakers at the Columbus Day dinner of Rochester Council in the Sheraton Hotel.
 As sons of Columbus, the discoverer of America, the knights were urged to help maintain the ideals of the great Catholic explorer.
 His Excellency Bishop Kearney cited current statistics of the parochial school system. "If we did not believe in the immortality of the soul," he said, "we wouldn't be concerned with educating our own."
 "With our juvenile delinquency is a sin you have to begin in childhood to develop those powers which keep people from committing sin," the Bishop said.
 "Why is it, Bishop Kearney asked, that when a boy is first admitted to the State School at Industry, it is immediately considered necessary for him to see Father Joseph Vogt or the Protestant Chaplain; at Elmira City for either Father Joseph McNamara or the chaplain of an other faith and at Elmira Reformatory Monsignor Francis J. Lane or the other chaplain? Yet before the boy is committed the Bishop pointed out, no religion is deemed due the boy by the State, on the basis of what they term "separation of Church and State."
 Patriotism in Catholic schools is considered a moral obligation. Joseph M. Foley, past state deputy and principal lay speaker declared in defense of the parochial schools.
 THE FACT THAT 88 boys from Aquinas Institute gave their lives in defense of their country as commemorated in the Aquinas Memorial Stadium, he said, is an answer to those who protest the Catholic School's existence.
 Tribute to Christopher Columbus was paid by Christopher H. D'Amanda, toastmaster. Welcome was extended by Grand Knight Raymond L. Nary. Chairman Dr. Francis J. Masiello opened the program.
 Knights added to their observance of Columbus Day at a Mass at 9:30 a. m. in St. Joseph's.
