British Women Fight Sale Of Contraceptives

By JOHN A. GREAVES London — (AP) — A demand that the sale of contraceptives from automatic machines be outlawed has been made by the National Board of Catholic Women's Conference.

In a resolution being sent to the Prime Minister, the Minister of Town and Country Planning, and the Minister of Health, they declared:

"This conference... representing the main women's societies in the Catholic community, is greatly disturbed to note that slot machines are being utilized for the sale of contraceptives.

MacArthur Advisers Push Birth Control

Czech Catholic Journalist Flees Red Terrorism

IN THE name of God, I am writing from a free country. The man who thus announced his escape from the open and hidden terror of a tyrannical regime—his memory haunted by a previous communist arrest—is Vaclav Myslivec.

Accompanied by his wife, he made his way to freedom, with the shots of frontier guards and the barking of police dogs ringing in his ears.

It was a hard decision to make for Vaclav Myslivec. He is not a person easily cowed or intimidated by threats.
