Plans for the annual Thanksgiving Festival, scheduled for Sunday, Nov. 14, in the school hall, will be made.

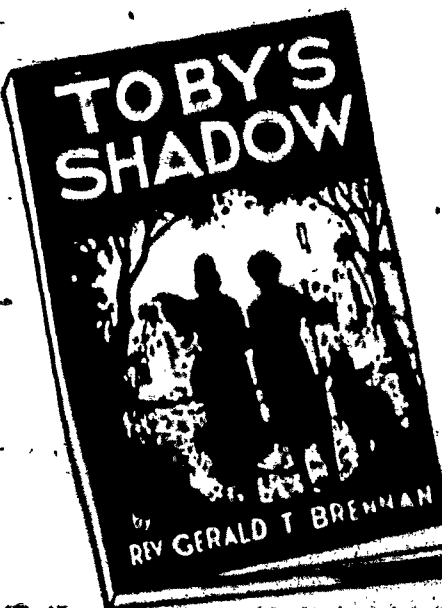
