Catholic Radio Speakers Plan Quizzing By Laymen

Washington — (NC) — The question-and-answer technique will be introduced on the Hour of Faith, long time popular Catholic radio program on Sunday, January 1. It has been announced by the National Council of Catholic Men, producer of the program.

The Hour of Faith is heard each Sunday at 11:30 a. m., EST. over the American Broadcasting Company network and WARC, Rochester.

The change in the program will work this way: the speaker, a top flight Catholic orator, will present a five to eight minute talk on his chosen subject. Then he will be joined by a prominent guest for a question-and-answer period during which the subject for the day will be thoroughly explored with the guest posing pertinent questions, the speaker, in a style suited to his Catholic and non-Catholic audience, giving the answers. The questioner will be a widely known Catholic layman or woman.

First speaker in the new series will be the Rev. Urban Nagle O.P. co-founder of the Blackfriars Guild movement and director of the Blackfriars Guild in New York. Father Nagle also is prominent in the work of the National Catholic Theater Conference.

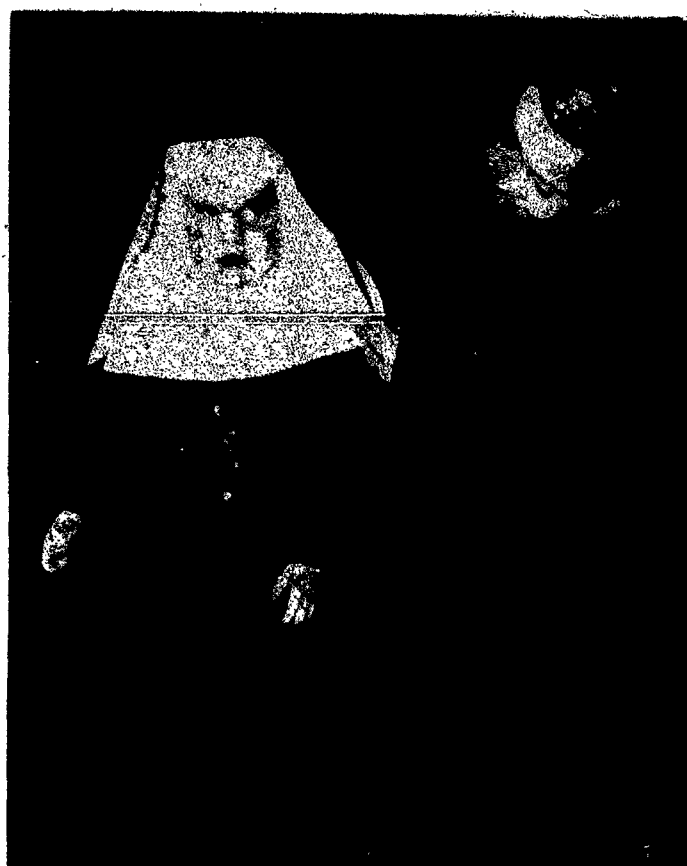

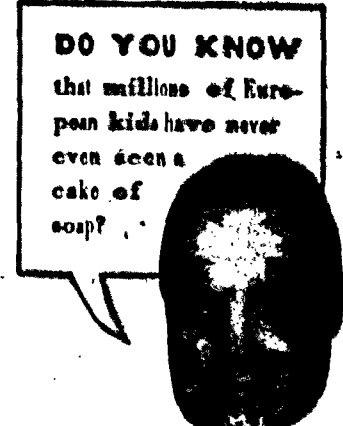
