Besides the above, homeown mothers will assist at the sale. Proceeds will be used for current prospects planned for the year.



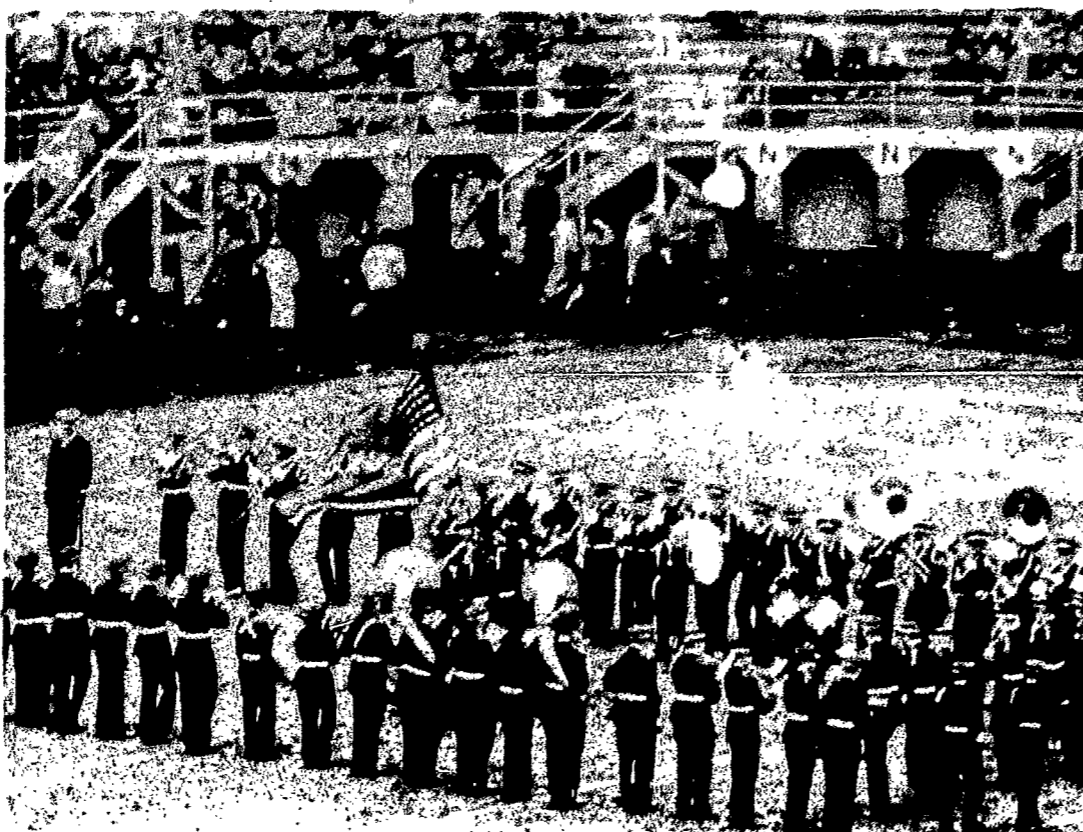

Playing and singing in the glare of a giant victory bonfire, Professor Raymond J. Hasenauer's musicians will whip the rally crowd into feverish anticipation of the season's climax game, set for 11 a. m. Thursday morning in the new Memorial Stadium.

Cheers, speeches and pre-game predictions, plus the encouragement of invited Aquinas stars of other years, will fill the hour's program. All students, Aquinas alumni, the Men's Club and general public are invited to attend. The Thanksgiving Day band program planned for between the halves of the Boys Town game will be one of the finest of the year, according to Hasenauer. "A real holiday treat for the eye and the ear," he said mysteriously. "We are serving roast turkey and all the fixings. Little mascot lobby Mirquet will be featured in the act and our cheerleaders will do a 'Hungry Appetite Dance' followed by the arrival of 'Papa' to carve. The audience will also have a treat in hearing 'Lover Come Back to Me' a vocal solo by Russell Cassata accompanied by the band."

THE 71 PIECE BAND smartly uniformed in maroon with white trim has entertained at each Little Irish game for many seasons. Besides their continuous music they perform weekly mid-field formations worked out by Hasenauer in the finest college band style. The 76-voice Glee Club entertains occasionally with the band. They were featured in the dedication ceremonies of the Memorial Stadium.

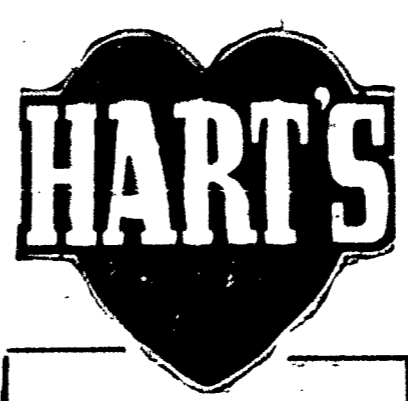
Representatives of 65 colleges in New York State were present at this meeting which was under the direction of Theodore Ross, w. g. director of guidance in the Utica schools.
