Besides the above, homeseem mothers will assist at the sale. Proceeds will be used for current prospects planned for the year.



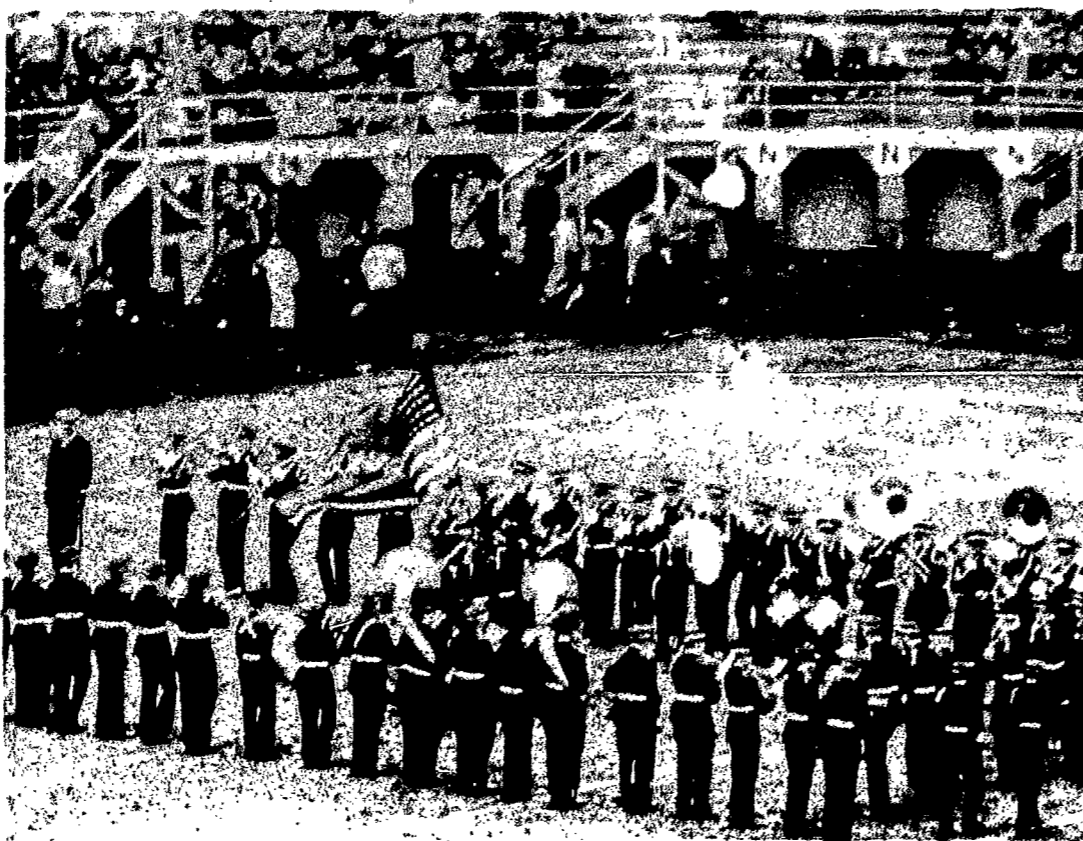

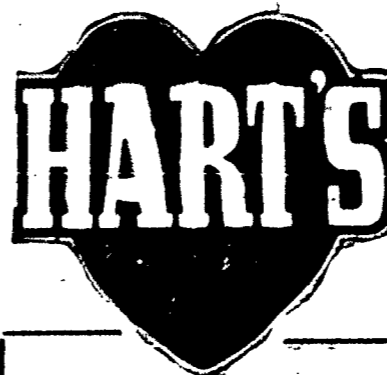

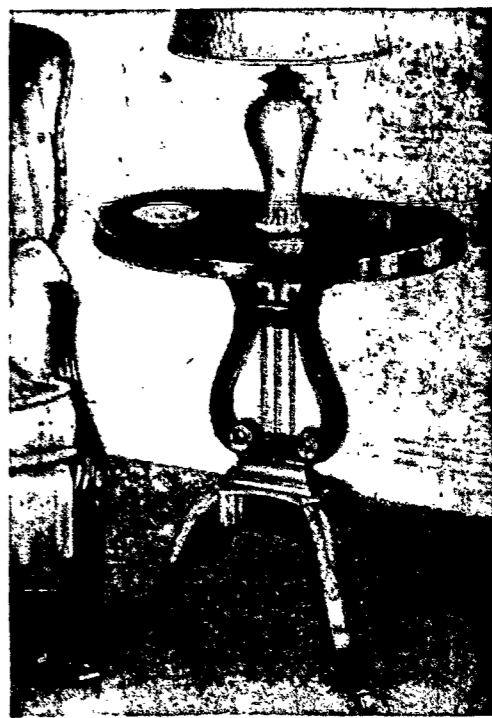
