

Convert Layman In Japan Organizes New 'Boys Town'

Tokyo — (CIP) — A Japanese Catholic who decided to follow the example of the Monsignor Edward J. Flanagan after meeting him during his visit to Japan in 1947, has started a "Boys Town" on a tract of land donated by the Government.

He is Mr. Ignatius Ikeda, a prominent lawyer in the city of Kofu. He has named the community "Angels' Court" (Tenshin-ko). Its first members are ten orphans placed in Mr. Ikeda's care by the city authorities of Tokyo.

THE "BOYS TOWN" is located in a mountainous district some fifty miles north of Kofu. Four buildings have already been erected on the property, which when completed will accommodate 100 orphans. A sawmill, school, and chapel will be built.

Farming and the raising of sheep and goats are expected to help make "Angels' Court" self-sufficient in the near future.

Letters Urged For Justice To Card. Mindszenty

Lima — Letters to the American delegation to the General Assembly of the United Nations, requesting early World Court adjudication in the case of the imprisonment of Cardinal Mindszenty, were urged in an address here by Frederick J. Vothbeck of Richmond Hill, N. Y.

Vothbeck, chairman of the United Catholic Organizations for the Freeing of Cardinal Mindszenty, spoke to members of Court of St. Rose Catholic Daughters of America.

Vothbeck said he is continuing his demand on all 14 members of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee to resist any efforts for U. S. recognition of the Chinese Reds.

The U. S. Department of State, the speaker declared, has acknowledged receipt of the protest and replied that it was being brought to the attention of officers of the Department directly concerned with Chinese affairs.

Vothbeck said a new movie "Guilty of Treason," based on the trial of Cardinal Mindszenty, soon will be shown in the New York area. It stars Charles Bickford, Paul Kelly and Bonita Granville.

The conference conducted by the Rev. Dr. Joseph F. Egan, professor of Theology, St. Bernard's Seminary, was an afternoon affair of prayer, talks and discussions aimed to give married couples a better insight into the real purpose and nature of marriage in God's plan and to help them to better accomplish the goal of their vocation.

It is believed that the Cana Conference fills a real need among Catholic married people who are so often bombarded with false philosophies of life and subject to the influence of practices contrary to the laws of God, the conference brought out.

Such conferences are intended not only to answer the questions and difficulties of married life but also to strengthen and revivify that life together that has been consecrated by Jesus Christ. It is expected that another Conference of this kind will be held in the early Spring.

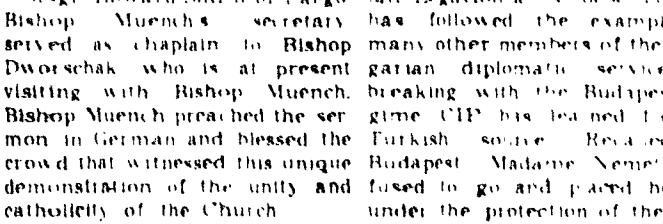
American Bishops Consecrate German

Frankfurt (N.Y.) — An event believed to be unique in German history took place at St. Godard's Church in Hildesheim when an American Bishop and his auxiliary consecrated a German Bishop.

The Most Rev. Johannes B. Dolek was consecrated as Auxiliary Bishop of Hildesheim by Bishop Aloisius J. Muench of Fargo, who is Apostolic Visitor in Germany, with Bishop Leo F. Dworschak, Auxiliary of Fargo serving as one of the consecrators. The other consecrators were Bishop Joseph Godard and the auxiliary of Hildesheim.

Monsignor Howard Smith of Fargo Bishop Muench's secretary served as chaplain to Bishop Dworschak who is at present visiting with Bishop Muench. Bishop Muench preached the sermon in German and blessed the crowd that witnessed this unique demonstration of the unity and catholicity of the Church.
