Gretta Palmer, a convert of Monsignor Fulton J. Sheen, was received into the Church at Christmas, 1948. Besides authorship of frequent articles in secular magazines, she writes a syndicated column for the national Catholic press, "The Top of My Mind," which is a weekly feature of the Courier Journal. BORN IN Missouri, she attended Mary Institute and Vasar College, from which she graduated into a staff writing job on the New Yorker. A few years later she turned to newspaper work, and became a daily columnist and Woman's Page Editor for the New York World-Telegram.

In recent years she has been writing for such national magazines as Readers Digest, Cosmopolitan and Ladies' Home Journal. Her writing was Catholic long before her religion was Catholicism. Gretta Palmer turned her hand to articles on medical research, sociology, Hollywood, psychiatry, marriage, fashions... whatever topic came along. During the war she spent some months in both Europe and Asia as a war correspondent. HER BOOK, "God's Underground," was published in January, 1949, by Appleton-Century and was the selection of the Catholic Literary Foundation for that month. It was written in collaboration with Father George a Croat priest who spent many months in Moscow, inside the USSR and discovered there a vast, fervent network of secret

Father Cirincione will be spiritual director of the American pilgrimage to the Portuguese shrine next summer. It will be met in Lisbon by the Most Rev. Manuel Maria Ferreira da Silva, Titular Archbishop of Cizico and director of the Propagation of the Faith Society in Portugal. Archbishop da Silva is a close friend and spiritual director of Sister Mary Lucy of the Immaculate Heart, sole survivor of the three children to whom Our Lady appeared at Fatima in 1917. Sister Lucy is now a Carmelite nun and though no visitors are allowed, as her spiritual director Archbishop da Silva sees her regularly.

The Archbishop, who speaks Portuguese, Italian and some English, will accompany the pilgrims to Fatima, where they will participate in the celebration of the Feast of Aug. 13. The pilgrims then will proceed to Rome where they will spend the Feast and Octave of the Assumption, including the Feast of the Immaculate Heart of Mary on Aug. 22. The pilgrimage then will go to Paris, Lourdes and Lisieux. The Archbishop will make the entire trip.

**Three Priests Tried In Poland**  
London —(RNS)— Six Poles, including three Roman Catholic priests, have been brought to trial before a regional military court in Rzeszow, south Poland, on charges of assisting anti-Communist groups, according to a Vatican Radio broadcast.

The priests were identified as the Revs. Wojciech Lorenz of Stojanica; Stanislaw Kulak of Gniezeczyna; and Stanislaw Zubir, vicar of Gniezeczyna. The civilians were two church sextons and a cemetery worker. All six were accused of complicity with the NSZ (National Military Forces), an underground group. They were also charged with illegal possession of weapons and rendering "spiritual aid."
