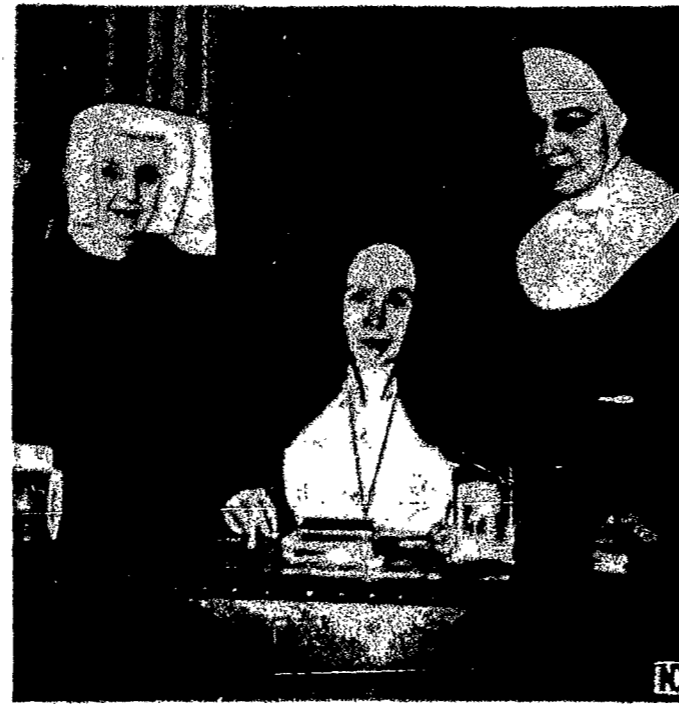

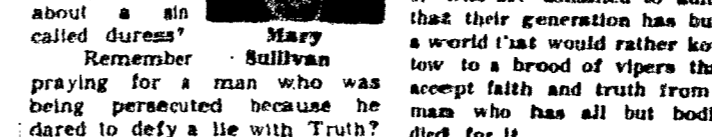

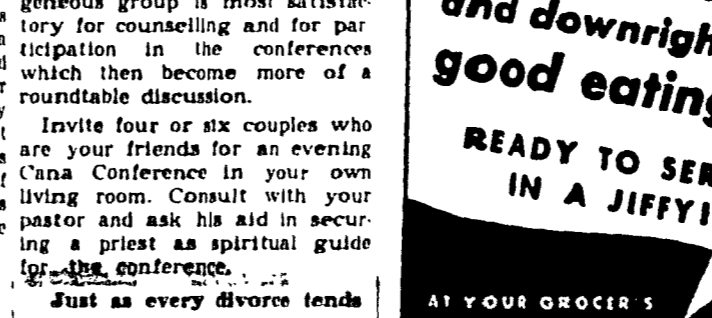

It's really a Refugee's nightmare. The paper goes on: "Cases of influenza, measles and scarlet fever were reported to have broken out at several camps." All this in Palestine. Water is plentiful, too much so. Food and clothing are scarce; tearfully so. Ten dollars for a food package, five dollars for a blanket and supplies will fight disease and death among our Refugees.

MILLIONS FOR DEFENSE

Not but a penny for tribute. Isn't that the line? We're not asking for millions. But a few dollars will at once protect the dignity of the Mass and be tribute to The Master. We need restrooms for our mission churches. \$30 will buy a full set.

A WOMAN'S AGE

It's none of our business. But she told us: on a list of names of novices needing financial help to continue their preparation for the sisterhood. Sister Bernadette (secular name Jeanette), is 25 years old. Takes a bit of courage to start the novitiate at that age over there. Especially when you're dependent on others for the financial help. Disappointing, too, to have to quit for want of the \$300 needed for support during the two years of novitiate. Do you care to insure the happiness of a 25-year-old woman? It's a good risk.

A BUNCH OF DRIPS

School can be an awful place if you have a bunch of drips in your class. And that's just the case in many mission schools. There's a bunch of drips in almost every class because the roof and walls are so badly in need of repair. To aid our schools we have the BASILIAN Club. A dollar a month makes you a member.
