Students' Rome Pilgrimage For 554 Sails In August

The National Federation of Catholic College Students are planning a Holy Year Student Pilgrimage to Rome in August, 1950, Nazareth College students announced this week.

Five different tours ranging in price from \$521 to \$554, which will include trips to Paris, Brussels, Florence, and Rome, are being arranged by an International Catholic Travel Committee.

These tours are open to all persons, students and non-students between the ages of 16-30. There is no age limit for religious and lay members of Catholic college faculties to whom special consideration will be given in accommodations.

The tour prices include round-trip steamship travel, overland transportation, hotel accommodations, meals, sightseeing, entrance fees taxes and gratuities, and services of tour escorts.

In Rome the American students will participate in ceremonies in Rome's major basilicas and will take part in a special audience with the Holy Father. A special itinerary has been arranged for those who desire summer study at the University of Fribourg.

Chaplains and moderators will travel with each group of student pilgrims and adequate guides will be provided for sightseeing.
