Frankfurt (AP)—Protestant churches frequently are made available to Catholics who have no church space of their own. In one instance the visiting priest found himself facing a picture of Martin Luther while offering the Holy Sacrament of the Mass. "I prayed for the repose of his soul," he said afterwards.

German army chaplains recall similar experiences of having said Mass in quarters decorated with pictures of Hitler or Mussolini. "The contrast," remarked one of these priests in this correspondent, "always was vivid—but we got over it!"

### Rabbi Backs Catholics On Birth Control, Euthanasia

Providence, R. I. (AP)—The Roman Catholic position on birth control and euthanasia was defended here by a Jewish rabbi.

Rabbi Abraham Ohlil of Congregation Bona of Abraham declared the Catholic viewpoint to be "commendable" because it is consistent in opposing all usurpation of God's authority over human life.

Father Gefell, we now give you back to God, thankful that we have known you for so many years. We give you back to God with the prayer of the Church upon our lips. May the angels lead you unto Paradise, may the saints receive your coming and mayst thou with Lazarus have life everlasting.
