Passed by the Senate of the United States and about to be considered by the House of Representatives is a ridiculous item of legislation called the Equal Rights Amendment.

The magazine article concludes by saying that the backers of the measure "advised members of the House." Why "advised?" Congressmen know that they will be seized by the supporters of the amendment with the same weapons reportedly used on the Senators— "documents, dialectics, plain talk and implied political threats."

Catholic women, along with many non-sectarian and inter-denominational groups such as the American Association of University Women and the National League of Women Voters, are unalterably opposed to this amendment.

OUR HOLY FATHER has said to modern women, "Your own role is to influence legislation and administration by the proper use of your prerogatives as a citizen."

If you want your representative in Congress to vote against this measure, write him today and tell him that you are opposed to it because the proposed Equal Rights Amendment may possibly have the following effects:

2. Affect family relationships, presumably abolishing the primary duty of the husband to support the family.
