The school was opened in Sept. 1942. It was admitted to the University of the State of New York by the Board of Regents and in January 1944 the first Regent examinations were held.
In 1948 the high school was conducted in St. Francis de Sales school on Exchange St. Need for expansion of both elementary and high school called for larger quarters for both institutions, and in 1929 at the suggestion of the late Bishop John O'Brien of the Rochester diocese plans were made for providing a new high school.
During the first three years of its existence only temporary classrooms were used. These were portions of the old parish hall, which was located on the second floor of the school building.
